3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Virginia Public Procurement Act; cooperative procurement; certain councils of governments.

5. Summary: Provides that a public body may purchase from the contract of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. The bill also provides that a public body may participate in, sponsor, conduct, or administer a cooperative procurement agreement on behalf of or in conjunction with the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final; fiscal impact is indeterminate. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate. The bill allows public bodies to utilize and participate in cooperative procurement agreements with the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. As a council of governments, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments is a nongovernmental, voluntary association of elected public officials. Therefore, its contracts are not subject to or executed under the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA) or other Commonwealth procurement policies and procedures. Public bodies' use of such contracts may result in contract terms inconsistent with those normally executed under VPPA and may provide less legal protection to the purchasing public body.

Statewide contracts are designed to leverage the collective purchasing power of the state to lower costs. If purchases utilizing the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments' contracts decrease those of statewide contracts, statewide contracts may have less leverage to negotiate.
