4. Title: Seizure of property; inventory required.

5. Summary: The legislation requires the agency seizing property to, as soon as practicable, conduct an inventory of the seized property and provide a copy of such inventory to the property owner.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation provides that when any property is seized for the purposes of forfeiture under Chapter 22.2 (§19.2-386.15 et seq.) or other forfeiture provision under the Code, the agency seizing property to, as soon as practicable, shall conduct an inventory of the seized property and provide a copy of such inventory to the property owner. An agency's failure to provide a copy of an inventory does not invalidate any forfeiture. The bill has no fiscal impact on state agencies.
