4. Title: Seizure of property; inventory required.

5. Summary: The proposal requires the agency seizing property to issue contemporaneously with the seizure, a receipt itemizing the property seized.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The substitute provides that when any property is seized for the purposes of forfeiture under Chapter 22.2 (§ 19.2-386.15 et seq.) or other forfeiture provision under the Code, the agency seizing the property shall as soon as practicable after the seizure, conduct an inventory of the seized property and shall, upon request of the owner of the property, provide a copy of the inventory to the owner. An agency's failure to provide a copy of an inventory does not invalidate any forfeiture.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
