3. Committee: Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Workers' compensation; exclusion of certain truck owner-operators.

5. Summary: Excludes any owner-operator of a motor vehicle that is leased with or to a common or contract carrier in the trucking industry from the definition of an employee for purposes of the Virginia Workers' Compensation Act, if certain conditions establish that the owner-operator is an independent contractor. The engrossed version of the bill contains technical amendments that were approved by the Senate.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Workers' Compensation Commission, this legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
