Summary: Directs the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to publish a report by July 1, 2016, consisting of a list of sites that the Department is aware of and that have (i) a managed solid waste, hazardous waste, hazardous substance, or other substance within the jurisdiction of the Waste Management Board or (ii) been required or volunteered to conduct a remedial action under an order or regulations of the Waste Management Board. This revised fiscal impact statement reflects a one-time expenditure impact to DEQ.

The second enactment provides that the provisions of this bill shall not become effective unless an appropriation effectuating its purposes is included in a general appropriation act passed in 2015 by the General Assembly.
