- **5. Summary:** As enrolled, this bill extends the entitlement to obtain a state resident license to hunt, trap, or fish to the immediate family members of members of the armed forces. Current law entitles members of the armed forces to obtain such a license. The bill also makes technical amendments.

Fiscal Implications: The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries does not estimate a substantial increase or decrease in resident versus non-resident license sales as a result of this legislation.
