- **4. Title:** Carbon monoxide emissions; exempted from certain diesel-powered incinerators.
- **5. Summary:** This bill provides that carbon monoxide emissions from any diesel-powered incinerator that is installed prior to July 1, 2015, owned by a locality, and used exclusively for the incineration of animal carcasses collected from the public rights-of-way shall be exempt from the State Air Pollution Control Board's air permitting. The provisions of this bill shall expire on July 1, 2019.
