3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Carbon monoxide emissions; exempted from certain diesel-powered incinerators.

5. Summary: This bill provides that carbon monoxide emissions from any diesel-powered incinerator that is installed prior to July 1, 2015, owned by a locality, and used exclusively for the incineration of animal carcasses collected from the public rights-of-way shall be exempt from the State Air Pollution Control Board's air permitting. The provisions of this bill shall expire on July 1, 2019.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill could have minimal impact on permit revenue collected by the Department of Environmental Quality. It is anticipated that any expenditure impact could be absorbed within existing resources.
