<b>Title:</b> Virginia Administrative Process Act; default by non-appearing party.
<b>Summary:</b> Establishes a mechanism to more efficiently dispose of contested matters under the Virginia Administrative Process Act where the defendant in an administrative proceeding fails to appear at a hearing without a valid excuse. Currently, unless an agency's enabling statute provides differently, there is no provision for allowing an agency to enter a default order in a case in which the defendant fails to appear at a hearing.

Fiscal Implications: None.
<b>Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:</b> All state agencies that hold hearings and are not exempt from the Administrative Process Act, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Supreme Court.

**11. Other Comments:** A prior version of this bill had a negative fiscal impact for the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS). The current version provides an exemption for DMAS that removes the fiscal impact.
