4. Title: Department of Juvenile Justice; access to criminal history record information.

5. Summary: Adds the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) to the list of entities authorized to receive information from the Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN). The bill specifies that DJJ may receive background checks from VCIN in order to complete pre-dispositional and post-dispositional reports required by law.
