3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Virginia Military Advisory Council (VMAC); membership.

5. Summary: Reduces the number of members of the Virginia Military Advisory Council (VMAC) from 27 to 11. The bill increases the number of appointments by the Governor by one and eliminates 17 members who represent the major military commands and installations located in Virginia. However, the Governor is required to invite representatives of the commands and installations to represent their command or installation at the VMAC meetings. The bill further requires that funding for the costs of compensation and expenses of the VMAC members be provided by the Secretary of Veterans and Defense Affairs. The bill contains technical amendments.
