 Fairfax County Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, David Bolte also worked to strengthen and enhance the community as cochair of the
 Mount Vernon Council of Citizens Associations, where he chaired the planning and zoning committee;

WHEREAS, over the course of his military career, David Bolte earned numerous awards and decorations, including the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and the Legion of Merit; and

WHEREAS, David Bolte will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 58 years,
Mary; children, Benjamin, John, Damara, and Kathryn, and their families; and numerous family
members and friends; now, therefore, be it
