HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 554

Commending Charlie Clark.

Agreed to by the House of Delegates, August 17, 2015

WHEREAS, born in 1907 in Hamilton, Charlie Clark joined many of the other young men of his generation in service to his country during World War II as a member of the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Clark served with the 3238th Quartermaster Service Company, an all-black unit in the 9th Armored Division; and

WHEREAS, after his honorable discharge, Charlie Clark relocated to Purcellville, where he worked in an apple orchard, as a barber, and as a school bus driver; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, Charlie Clark moved to the Martinsburg VA Medical Center Community Living Center in West Virginia; he brings joy to his fellow residents with his laid back demeanor; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That Charlie Clark, a respected veteran in Martinsburg, hereby be commended on the occasion of his 108th birthday; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Charlie Clark as an expression of the House of Delegates' congratulations and admiration for his service to the Commonwealth and the United States.
