2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 3.2-6402 of the Code of Virginia, relating to warning signs at*  
3 *agritourism locations.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 3.2-6402 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 3.2-6402. Notice required.**

9 A. Every agritourism professional shall post and maintain signs that contain the ~~warning~~ notice  
10 specified in subsection B. The sign shall be placed in a clearly visible location at the entrance to the  
11 agritourism location and at the site of the agritourism activity. The ~~warning~~ notice shall consist of a sign  
12 in black letters, with each letter to be a minimum of one inch in height. Every written contract entered  
13 into by an agritourism professional for the providing of professional services, instruction, or the rental of  
14 equipment to a participant, whether or not the contract involves agritourism activities on or off the  
15 location or at the site of the agritourism activity, shall contain in clearly readable print the ~~warning~~  
16 notice specified in subsection B.

17 B. The signs and contracts described in subsection A shall contain the following notice ~~of warning~~:  
18 ~~"WARNING ATTENTION: "WARNING" or "ATTENTION" followed by "Under Virginia law, there is~~  
19 ~~no liability for an injury to or death of a participant in an agritourism activity conducted at this~~  
20 ~~agritourism location if such injury or death results from the inherent risks of the agritourism activity.~~  
21 ~~Inherent risks of agritourism activities include, among others, risks of injury inherent to land, equipment,~~  
22 ~~and animals, as well as the potential for you to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to your~~  
23 ~~injury or death. You are assuming the risk of participating in this agritourism activity."~~

24 C. Failure to comply with the requirements concerning ~~warning~~ signs and notices provided in this  
25 section shall prevent an agritourism professional from invoking the privileges of immunity provided by  
26 this chapter.
