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## HOUSE BILL NO. 1255

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on Counties, Cities and Towns

on February 12, 2016)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Pillion)

A BILL to amend and reenact § 15.2-7205 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the BVU Authority.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 15.2-7205 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 15.2-7205. Board of Directors; membership.

A. The powers of the Authority shall be vested in an *the* Authority Board of Directors consisting of
 nine seven directors. The number of Directors on the Board may directors shall not be increased altered
 by the Authority Board.

B. The Authority's Authority Board, which will initially take office on July 1, 2010, However,
 beginning on July 1, 2016, the Authority Board shall be constituted as follows:

15 1. Four One director who is a citizen of the City of Bristol, Virginia, citizen appointees and is not a
16 member of the Bristol City Council, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates. The four
17 Bristol, Virginia, citizen appointees currently on the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board are hereby directors
18 on the Authority's Board and their respective terms are extended on the Authority Board as follows:

19 a. The term ending June 30, 2010, will be extended to end June 30, 2014.

20 b. The term ending June 30, 2011, will be extended to end June 30, 2015.

21 c. The second term ending June 30, 2011, will be extended to end June 30, 2016.

d. The term ending June 30, 2012, will be extended to end June 30, 2016.

Each of said members will thereafter be eligible for one additional consecutive four year term
 pursuant to the limitation set forth herein.

25 2. Two members appointed by One director who is a member of the Bristol City Council who are
 26 members of, appointed by the Bristol City Council serving on the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board as of
 27 June 1, 2010. Such members shall to serve a four-year term, coterminous with their his term on the
 28 Council, commencing July 1, 2010. Should no present member of Council serving on the Bristol
 29 Virginia Utilities Board be a member of Council on that date, Council may appoint two other members
 30 of Council to serve on the initial Authority Board for a term that is coterminous with that member's
 31 term on Council.
 32 3. One new Bristol, Virginia, citizen, who is not a city council member. Such citizen will be director

33 who is a citizen of Washington County and is not a member of the Washington County Board of
34 Supervisors, appointed by the Bristol, Virginia, City Council and shall serve a term from July 1, 2010,
35 until June 30, 2015 Senate Committee on Rules.

4. One new member, a director who is a citizen of the City of Bristol, Virginia, citizen, appointed by
the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board whose term will start July 1, 2010, and end June 30, 2014 who is
engaged in business and is not a member of the Bristol City Council, appointed by the Authority Board.
However, the first such director shall be appointed by the Bristol City Council for a term that ends the
sooner of July 1, 2017, or the date upon which the Authority Board appoints a director to this position
to serve the remainder of the initial four-year term. The Authority Board shall appoint a director to this

43 5. One *director who is a* member of the Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Virginia, who
44 will be *Board of Supervisors*, appointed by that the Washington County Board of Supervisors to serve a
45 four-year term coterminous with his or her term on the Board of Supervisors commencing July 1, 2010.

6. One director who is a member of the Abingdon Town Council, appointed by the Abingdon Town
Council to serve a four-year term coterminous with his term on the Town Council.

48 7. One director who is a Scott County citizen and is not a member of the Scott County Board of
 49 Supervisors, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates.

50 C. If any appointments to the initial Board are made prior to the effective date of this chapter, such 51 appointments shall be deemed valid and effective as of such date The four-year term of all directors 52 shall begin July 1, 2016. The term of Authority Board membership for any director thereafter shall be 53 four years.

D. The City Council shall elect, in addition to its Council members, three of the Bristol, Virginia, citizen Board members when the above terms expire. The remaining three Bristol, Virginia, citizen members will be elected by the Authority Board when the above terms expire. The City Council and the Authority Board will alternate electing persons to fill an expiring term until each has appointed the number it appoints to the Board. Any vacancy in a term shall be filled by the body making the original appointment and shall be for the remainder of the term. Said appointment shall be made within 30 days 60 from the date the vacancy occurs.

61 E. The term of the Council members shall be for four years coterminous with those members' terms 62 of office on the City Council. Those City Council Members Each director who is a member of the 63 Abingdon Town Council, Bristol City Council, or Washington County Board of Supervisors may serve as many terms as the City Council appointing governing body decides as long as the appointees are 64 65 members appointee remains a member of the City Council relevant governing body. The City Council 66 governing body may appoint other members a different member of the City Council or Board of Supervisors at the end of any appointee's four-year Council or Board term or upon the exit of the 67 Council member from the Council governing body. In the latter case, the Council Member will new 68 69 appointee shall serve for the remainder of the term vacated by an exiting City Council member of the 70 governing body.

71 F. All other directors shall serve four year terms, except for the longer appointments to the initial 72 Board. Those directors may serve a maximum of two terms and then must be off the Board for one full 73 year before election to fill another full term or to fill the remainder of a vacated term.

74 G. E. If funds are available, each director may be reimbursed by the Authority for the amount of 75 actual expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties. Such expense allowance shall constitute a cost of operation and maintenance of such utility systems and shall be prorated among each 76 of the systems it manages using the "3-Factor" "Three-Factor" allocation method approved by the 77 78 Commission. The three factors consist of the percentages that each division comprises of total plant in 79 service, total operating revenues, and total customer accounts. Once each operating division's percentage 80 of each of the three factors is calculated, the sum of the three factors divided by 3 three results in the 81 operating division's share of the total direct or indirect costs.

## 2. That § 15.2-7205 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 82 83

§ 15.2-7205. Board of Directors; membership.

A. The powers of the Authority shall be vested in an the Authority Board of Directors consisting of 84 85 nine five directors. The number of Directors on the Board may directors shall not be increased altered 86 by the Authority Board.

87 B. The Authority's Authority Board, which will initially take office on July 1, 2010, shall be 88 constituted as follows:

89 1. Four One director who is a citizen of the City of Bristol, Virginia, citizen appointees and is not a 90 member of the Bristol City Council, appointed by the Governor. The four Bristol, Virginia, citizen 91 appointees currently on the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board are hereby directors on the Authority's Board 92 and their respective terms are extended on the Authority Board as follows:

93 a. The term ending June 30, 2010, will be extended to end June 30, 2014.

94 b. The term ending June 30, 2011, will be extended to end June 30, 2015.

95 e. The second term ending June 30, 2011, will be extended to end June 30, 2016.

d. The term ending June 30, 2012, will be extended to end June 30, 2016. 96

97 Each of said members will thereafter be eligible for one additional consecutive four-year term 98 pursuant to the limitation set forth herein.

99 2. Two members appointed by One director who is a member of the Bristol City Council who are 100 members of, appointed by the Bristol City Council serving on the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board as of June 1, 2010. Such members shall to serve a four-year term, coterminous with their his term on the 101 Council, commencing July 1, 2010. Should no present member of Council serving on the Bristol 102 103 Virginia Utilities Board be a member of Council on that date, Council may appoint two other members 104 of Council to serve on the initial Authority Board for a term that is coterminous with that member's 105 term on Council.

106 3. One new Bristol, Virginia, citizen, who is not a city council member. Such citizen will be director 107 who is a citizen of Washington County and is not a member of the Washington County Board of 108 Supervisors, appointed by the Bristol, Virginia, City Council and shall serve a term from July 1, 2010, until June 30, 2015 Senate Committee on Rules. 109

110 4. One new member, a director who is a citizen of the City of Bristol, Virginia, citizen, appointed by the Bristol Virginia Utilities Board whose term will start July 1, 2010, and end June 30, 2014 who is 111 112 engaged in business and is not a member of the Bristol City Council, appointed by the Authority Board. However, the first such director shall be appointed by the Bristol City Council for a term that ends the 113 114 sooner of July 1, 2017, or the date upon which the Authority Board appoints a director to this position to serve the remainder of the initial four-year term. The Authority Board shall appoint a director to this 115 116 position thereafter.

117 5. One *director who is a* member of the Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Virginia, who 118 will be Board of Supervisors, appointed by that the Washington County Board of Supervisors to serve a 119 four-year term coterminous with his or her term on the Board of Supervisors commencing July 1, 2010.

120 C. If any appointments to the initial Board are made prior to the effective date of this chapter, such appointments shall be deemed valid and effective as of such date The four-year term of all directors 121

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122 shall begin July 1, 2016. The term of Authority Board membership for any director thereafter shall be 123 four years.

124 D. The City Council shall elect, in addition to its Council members, three of the Bristol, Virginia, 125 citizen Board members when the above terms expire. The remaining three Bristol, Virginia, citizen 126 members will be elected by the Authority Board when the above terms expire. The City Council and the 127 Authority Board will alternate electing persons to fill an expiring term until each has appointed the 128 number it appoints to the Board. Any vacancy in a term shall be filled by the body making the original 129 appointment and shall be for the remainder of the term. Said appointment shall be made within 30 days 130 from the date the vacancy occurs.

131 E. The term of the Council members shall be for four years coterminous with those members' terms 132 of office on the City Council. Those City Council Members Each director who is a member of the 133 Bristol City Council or Washington County Board of Supervisors may serve as many terms as the City 134 Council appointing governing body decides as long as the appointees are members appointee remains a member of the City Council relevant governing body. The City Council governing body may appoint other members a different member of the City Council or Board of Supervisors at the end of any 135 136 137 appointee's four-year Council or Board term or upon the exit of the Council member from the Council 138 governing body. In the latter case, the Council Member will new appointee shall serve for the remainder 139 of the term vacated by an exiting City Council member of the governing body.

140 F. All other directors shall serve four year terms, except for the longer appointments to the initial 141 Board. Those directors may serve a maximum of two terms and then must be off the Board for one full 142 year before election to fill another full term or to fill the remainder of a vacated term.

143 G. E. If funds are available, each director may be reimbursed by the Authority for the amount of 144 actual expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties. Such expense allowance shall constitute a cost of operation and maintenance of such utility systems and shall be prorated among each 145 of the systems it manages using the "3-Factor" "Three-Factor" allocation method approved by the 146 147 Commission. The three factors consist of the percentages that each division comprises of total plant in 148 service, total operating revenues, and total customer accounts. Once each operating division's percentage 149 of each of the three factors is calculated, the sum of the three factors divided by 3 three results in the 150 operating division's share of the total direct or indirect costs.

151 3. That upon the completion of the transfer to a third party of ownership of the Authority's 152 broadband service, commonly known as BVU OptiNet, the director who is a member of the 153 Abingdon Town Council, appointed by the Abingdon Town Council, and the director who is a 154 Scott County citizen and not a member of the Scott County Board of Supervisors, appointed by 155 the Speaker of the House of Delegates, shall both be removed from their directorships, and the 156 second enactment of this act shall become effective.

157 4. That this act shall not be construed to affect the contract of employment existing between the 158 BVU Authority or BVU Board of Directors and the Executive Vice-President and Chief Financial 159 Officer of the BVU Authority as of the effective date of this act.

160 6. That the members of the Board of Directors of the BVU Authority in office on June 30, 2016, are hereby removed from office as of July 1, 2016. Notwithstanding the appointment of any 161 162 director on or before July 1, 2010, or of his successor, any term of office begun before July 1,

163 2016, and scheduled to end after that date is hereby terminated. No person who was a member of

164 the Board of Directors in office on June 30, 2016, shall be eligible for reappointment to the Board

- 165 prior to July 1, 2018.
- 166 7. That no later than July 1, 2016, the Auditor of Public Accounts or his legally authorized representative shall examine the accounts and books of the BVU Authority. 167
- 168 8. That any sale or disposition of any of the Authority's assets shall be made in accordance with the BVU Authority Transition Agreement made between the City of Bristol, Virginia, and Bristol 169 170 Virginia Utilities, dated November 2, 2009.
- 171 9. That notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, general or special, the Bristol City Council
- 172 shall, as of the effective date of this act, have the authority to make the appointment of a member
- 173 of the Bristol City Council pursuant to subdivision B 2 of § 15.2-7205 of the Code of Virginia, as 174 amended by this act, for the term ending July 1, 2020.
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10. That notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, general or special, the Bristol City 176 Council shall, as of the effective date of this act, have the authority to make the appointment of a

- 177 citizen of the City of Bristol, Virginia, who is engaged in business and is not a member of the 178 Bristol City Council pursuant to subdivision B 4 of § 15.2-7205 of the Code of Virginia, as 179 amended by this act, for the term ending July 1, 2020.
- 180 11. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
