10 11	1. That § 54.1-3452 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 54.1-3452. Schedule IV. The controlled substances listed in this section are included in Schedule IV unless specifically
12	excepted or listed in another schedule:
14	1. Any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of the following
15	substances having a potential for abuse associated with a depressant effect on the central nervous
16	system:

Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, 79 or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances having a stimulant effect on the 80 central nervous system, including its salts, isomers (whether optical, position, or geometric), and salts of 81 such isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the 82 specific chemical designation:

- 83 Cathine (+)-norpseudoephedrine;
- Diethylpropion; 84
- 85 Fencamfamin;
- 86 Fenproprex;
- 87 Mazindol;
- 88 Mefenorex:
- 89 Modafinil:
- 90 Phentermine:
- 91 Pemoline (including organometallic complexes and chelates thereof);
- 92 Pipradrol;
- 93 Sibutramine;
- 94 SPA (-)-1-dimethylamino-1, 2-diphenylethane.

95 4. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation containing any of the following narcotic drugs, or their salts calculated as the free 96 97 anhydrous base or alkaloid, in limited quantities as set forth below:

98 Dextropropoxyphene (alpha-(+)-4-dimethylamino-1, 2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionoxy butane);

99 Not more than 1 milligram of difenoxin and not less than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate per 100 dosage unit;

101 2-[(dimethylamino) methyl]-1-(3-methoxyphenyl) cyclohexanol, its salts, optical and geometric 102 isomers, and salts of such isomers, including tramadol.

103 5. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, 104 or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances, including their salts:

- 105 Butorphanol (including its optical isomers):
- Eluxadoline (including its optical isomers); 106
- 107 Pentazocine.

108 6. The Board may except by regulation any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any depressant substance listed in subdivision 1 from the application of all or any part of this chapter if the 109 compound, mixture, or preparation contains one or more active medicinal ingredients not having a 110 depressant effect on the central nervous system, and if the admixtures are included therein in 111 combinations, quantity, proportion, or concentration that vitiate the potential for abuse of the substances 112 113 which have a depressant effect on the central nervous system.

2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 114 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot 115 be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 116 665 of the Acts of Assembly of 2015 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the 117 118 119 necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the

Department of Juvenile Justice. 120
