1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-132.1 as follows: 7 8 § 18.2-132.1. Trespass by hunters using dogs; penalty.

9 Any person who intentionally releases hunting dogs on the lands of another which have been posted

10 in accordance with the provisions of § 18.2-134.1 to hunt without the consent of the landowner or his

11 agent is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation of this section within three

12 years is a Class 1 misdemeanor and, upon conviction, the court shall revoke such person's hunting or

trapping license for a period of one year. The fact that hunting dogs are present on the lands of another 13

14 alone is not sufficient evidence to prove that the person acted intentionally. ENROLLED
