10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-3466 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-3466. Possession or distribution of controlled paraphernalia; meaning of controlled
13	paraphernalia; evidence; exceptions.
14	Except as authorized in this chapter, it shall be is a Class 2 misdemeanor for any person to possess
15	or distribute controlled paraphernalia which shall mean and a Class 1 misdemeanor for any person to
16	distribute controlled paraphernalia. For the purposes of this article, "controlled paraphernalia" means
17	(i) a hypodermic syringe, needle, or other instrument or implement or combination thereof adapted for
18	the administration of controlled dangerous substances by hypodermic injections under circumstances
19	which that reasonably indicate an intention to use such controlled paraphernalia for purposes of illegally
20	administering any controlled drug or (ii) gelatin capsules, glassine envelopes, or any other container
21	suitable for the packaging of individual quantities of controlled drugs in sufficient quantity to and under
22	circumstances which that reasonably indicate an intention to use any such item for the illegal
23	manufacture, distribution, or dispensing of any such controlled drug. Evidence of such circumstances
24	shall include, but not be limited to, close proximity of any such controlled paraphernalia to any
25	adulterants or equipment commonly used in the illegal manufacture and distribution of controlled drugs
26	including, but not limited to, scales, sieves, strainers, measuring spoons, staples and staplers, or procaine
27	hydrochloride, mannitol, lactose, quinine, or any controlled drug or any machine, equipment, instrument,
28	implement, device, or combination thereof which <i>that</i> is adapted for the production of controlled drugs
29	under circumstances which that reasonably indicate an intention to use such item or combination thereof
30	to produce, sell, or dispense any controlled drug in violation of the provisions of this chapter.
31	The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons who have acquired possession and control of
32	controlled paraphernalia in accordance with the provisions of this article or to any person who owns or

32 controlled paraphernalia in accordance with the provisions of this article or to any person who owns or 33 is engaged in breeding or raising livestock, poultry, or other animals to which hypodermic injections are 34 customarily given in the interest of health, safety, or good husbandry; or to hospitals, physicians, 35 pharmacists, dentists, podiatrists, veterinarians, funeral directors and embalmers, persons to whom a 36 permit has been issued, manufacturers, wholesalers, or their authorized agents or employees when in the 37 usual course of their business, if the controlled paraphernalia lawfully obtained continues continue to be 38 used for the legitimate purposes for which they were obtained.

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
