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## **HOUSE BILL NO. 196**

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-17.6, relating to public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions; information and forms.

**10** Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

11 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-17.6 as follows:

12 § 22.1-17.6. Public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions; information and 13 forms.

14 A. The Board shall adopt policies to ensure that the Department of Education does not require 15 public elementary or secondary schools or local school divisions to (i) provide information that is 16 already available to or housed within the Department of Education; (ii) provide the same written information more than once during a school year, absent a change in the underlying information; (iii) 17 complete forms for students with disabilities unless such forms are necessary to ensure compliance with 18 the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (20 USC § 1431 et seq.); or (iv) provide 19 information that is not necessary to comply with state or federal law unless such information is relevant 20 21 to student outcomes or the efficient operation of the public schools, provided that the Department of 22 Education may require such schools and local school divisions to provide any such information or 23 complete any such forms if the Department of Education demonstrates a compelling need or 24 demonstrates that it does not have a more expeditious method for obtaining the information or 25 completing the forms.

*B.* The Board shall permit public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions to submit all information and forms to the Department of Education electronically.

C. The Department of Education shall annually evaluate and determine the continued need for the information that it collects from public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions. In making such evaluation and determination, the Department of Education shall consider whether the information that it collects is required by state or federal law.

D. The Board shall report to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and the Senate 32 33 Committee on Education and Health by November 15 of each year on (i) information that public 34 elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions are required to provide to the Department 35 of Education pursuant to state law, (ii) the results of the annual evaluation and determination made by 36 the Department of Education pursuant to subsection C, (iii) any reports required of public elementary or 37 secondary schools or local school divisions that the Department of Education has consolidated, (iv) any 38 information that the Department of Education no longer collects from public elementary or secondary 39 schools or local school divisions, and (v) any forms that the Department of Education no longer 40 requires public elementary or secondary schools or local school divisions to complete.

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
