 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
 - 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-17.6 as follows:
- 10 § 22.1-17.6. Public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions; information and forms. 11

12 A. The Board shall adopt policies to ensure that the Department of Education does not require 13 public elementary or secondary schools or local school divisions to (i) provide information that is already available to or housed within the Department of Education; (ii) provide the same written 14 15 information more than once during a school year, absent a change in the underlying information; (iii) complete forms for students with disabilities unless such forms are necessary to ensure compliance with 16 the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. § 1431 et seq.); or (iv) provide 17 information that is not necessary to comply with state or federal law unless such information is relevant 18 to student outcomes or the efficient operation of the public schools, provided that the Department of 19 20 Education may require such schools and local school divisions to provide any such information or 21 complete any such forms if the Department of Education demonstrates a compelling need or 22 demonstrates that it does not have a more expeditious method for obtaining the information or 23 completing the forms.

24 B. The Department of Education shall study the transition to electronic submission of all information 25 and forms to the Department of Education by public elementary and secondary schools and local school 26 divisions and submit a report of its findings to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and 27 the Senate Committee on Education and Health no later than November 1, 2016.

28 C. The Department of Education shall annually evaluate and determine the continued need for the 29 information that it collects from public elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions. In 30 making such evaluation and determination, the Department of Education shall consider whether the information that it collects is required by state or federal law. 31

32 D. The Board shall report to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and the Senate 33 Committee on Education and Health by November 15 of each year on (i) information that public 34 elementary and secondary schools and local school divisions are required to provide to the Department 35 of Education pursuant to state law, (ii) the results of the annual evaluation and determination made by the Department of Education pursuant to subsection C, (iii) any reports required of public elementary or 36 secondary schools or local school divisions that the Department of Education has consolidated, (iv) any 37 38 information that the Department of Education no longer collects from public elementary or secondary 39 schools or local school divisions, and (v) any forms that the Department of Education no longer 40 requires public elementary or secondary schools or local school divisions to complete.

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
