10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. It shall be the duty of the officers conducting the next general election at which a proposed
12	constitutional amendment or statewide referendum is being submitted to the voters, at the places
13	appointed for holding the same, to open a poll and take the sense of the qualified voters on the question
14	stated below. The State Board of Elections shall have notice of the referendum published in accordance
15	with the provisions of § 30-19.10 of the Code of Virginia.
16	The ballots to be used at the election shall pose the question in substantially the following form:
17	QUESTION: "Should the Virginia General Assembly adopt a resolution to propose an amendment to
18 19	the Constitution of Virginia that would establish an independent redistricting commission to create and propose redistricting plans for House of Delegates, Senate of Virginia, and congressional districts?"
20	The ballots shall be prepared, distributed, and voted, and the results thereof ascertained and
2 0 2 1	certified, in the manner prescribed by Title 24.2 of the Code of Virginia. The State Board of Elections
$\overline{22}$	shall comply with § 30-19.10 of the Code of Virginia and shall cause to be sent to the electoral board
23	of each county and city sufficient copies of the question contained herein and a neutral explanation of
24	the question for the officers of election to post in each polling place on election day.
25	The electoral board of each county and city shall make out, certify, and forward an abstract of the
26	votes cast for and against the question in the manner now prescribed by law in relation to votes cast in
27	general elections.
28	The State Board of Elections shall open and canvass such abstracts and examine and report the
29 30	whole number of votes cast at the election for and against the question in the manner now prescribed by law in relation to votes cast in general elections. The State Board of Elections shall announce the
31	results of the referendum

results of the referendum. The expenses incurred in conducting this referendum shall be defrayed as in the case of other November general elections. The results of the referendum shall be advisory only.
