9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That §§ 33.2-2602 and 33.2-2604 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 33.2-2602. Composition of Commission.
13	The Commission shall consist of 23 members as follows:
14	1. The chief elected officer of the governing body of each of the 14 counties and 10 cities embraced
15	by the Commission;
16	2. A current elected official of each of the four counties embraced by the Commission, provided that
17	such official (i) serves on the governing body of the county and (ii) has been appointed by resolution of
18	such governing body to serve as the county's member on the Commission;
19 20	2. 3. Three members of the House of Delegates who reside in different counties or cities embraced by the Commission, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and two members of the Senate who reside
20 21	in different counties or cities embraced by the Commission, appointed by the Senate Committee on
22	Rules; and
23	3. 4. The following four persons serving as nonvoting ex officio members of the Commission: a
24	member of the Commonwealth Transportation Board who resides in a locality embraced by the
25	Commission and is appointed by the Governor; the Director of the Department of Rail and Public
26	Transportation, or his designee; the Commissioner of Highways, or his designee; and the Executive
27 28	Director of the Virginia Port Authority, or his designee. All members of the Commission shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Vacancies
20 29	shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.
3 0	The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its voting membership.
31	The Auditor of Public Accounts, or his legally authorized representatives, shall annually audit the
32	financial accounts of the Commission, and the cost of such audit shall be borne by the Commission.
33	§ 33.2-2604. Decisions of Commission.
34	A majority of the Commission, which majority shall include at least a majority of <i>the total of</i> the
35 36	chief elected officers of and elected officials who represent the counties and cities embraced by the Commission, shall constitute a quorum. Decisions of the Commission shall require a quorum and shall
30 37	be in accordance with voting procedures established by the Commission. In all cases, decisions of the
38	Commission shall require the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the Commission present
39	and voting, and two-thirds of the total of the chief elected officers of and elected officials who represent
40	the counties and cities embraced by Planning District 23 who are present and voting and whose counties
41	and cities include at least two-thirds of the population embraced by the Commission; however, no
42	motion to fund a specific facility or service shall fail because of this population criterion if such facility
43	or service is not located or to be located or provided or to be provided within the county or city whose ship algorithm of a service to fail to make the facility or coming to fail to make the facility of a service to fac
44 45	chief elected officer's or elected official's sole negative vote caused the facility or service to fail to meet the population criterion. The population of counties and cities ambrased by the Commission shall be the
45 46	the population criterion. The population of counties and cities embraced by the Commission shall be the population as determined by the most recently preceding decennial census, except that on July 1 of the
47	fifth year following such census, the population of each county and city shall be adjusted, based on
48	population estimates made by the Weldon Cooper Center for Public Service of the University of
49	Virginia.
