## HOUSE BILL NO. 35

A BILL to amend and reenact § 52-8.5 of the Code of Virginia, relating to reporting hate crimes.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

## 10 1. That § 52-8.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

## § 52-8.5. Reporting hate crimes.

A. The Superintendent shall establish and maintain within the Department of State Police a central
 repository for the collection and analysis of information regarding hate crimes and groups and
 individuals carrying out such acts.

B. State, county and municipal law-enforcement agencies shall report to the Department all hate
crimes occurring in their jurisdictions in a form, time and manner prescribed by the Superintendent.
Such reports shall not be open to public inspection except insofar as the Superintendent shall permit.

C. For purposes of this section, "hate crime" means (i) a criminal act committed against a person or 18 19 his property with the specific intent of instilling fear or intimidation in the individual against whom the 20 act is perpetrated because of race, religion, sexual orientation, gender identification, or ethnic origin or that is committed for the purpose of restraining that person from exercising his rights under the 21 22 Constitution or laws of this the Commonwealth or of the United States; (ii) any illegal act directed 23 against any persons or their property because of those persons' race, religion, sexual orientation, gender 24 identification, or national origin;; and (iii) all other incidents, as determined by law-enforcement 25 authorities, intended to intimidate or harass any individual or group because of race, religion, or national 26 origin.
