| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-936.1 as follows: |

| 13 | A. No law-enforcement officer as defined in § 9.1-101, while such officer is enforcing the traffic or |
| 14 | motor vehicle laws of the Commonwealth, shall use any motor vehicle unless such vehicle is (i) marked |
| 15 16 | in some distinctive manner that identifies the law-enforcement agency employing such officer and (ii) equipped with warning lights as provided in § 46.2-1022. |
| 17 | B. Subsection A shall not apply to any law-enforcement officer who: |
