A *BILL to amend and reenact § 16.1-132 of the Code of Virginia, relating to reckless driving; right to appeal.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 16.1-132 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 16.1-132. Right of appeal.

Any person convicted in a district court of an offense not felonious shall have the right, at any time within ~~ten~~ 10 days from such conviction, and whether or not such conviction was upon a plea of guilty, to appeal to the circuit court; *however, any person convicted of a misdemeanor offense of reckless driving who was tried in his absence shall have the right to appeal such conviction at any time within one year from such conviction.* There shall also be an appeal of right from any order or judgment of a district court forfeiting any recognizance or revoking any suspension of sentence.
