11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 6 of Chapter 4 of Title 18.2 a

13	§ 18.2-60.6. Enhanced penalty for conviction of certain misdemeanor offenses related to domestic
14	violence or stalking.
15	When a person is convicted of a misdemeanor offense under § 16.1-253.2, 18.2-57.2, 18.2-60.3, or
16	18.2-60.4 and it is alleged in the warrant, information, or indictment on which the person is convicted
17	and found by the court or jury trying the case that the person has previously been convicted within the
18	20-year period immediately preceding the offense charged of an offense under § 16.1-253.2, Article 4
19 20	(§ 18.2-51 et seq.), or § 18.2-60.3 or 18.2-60.4, and that the victim of the prior offense was the same
20	person who is the victim of the instant offense, he is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
21	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
22	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
23 24	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 665 of the Acts of Assembly of 2015 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to
