That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 57-2.03 as follows: 10 § 57-2.03. Religious freedom; solemnization of marriage. 11 A. No person authorized to perform a marriage ceremony pursuant to Chapter 2 (§ 20-13 et seq.) of 12 Title 20 shall be required to solemnize any marriage, and no religious organization, organization supervised or controlled by or operated in connection with a religious organization, individual employed 13 by a religious organization while acting in the scope of his employment, or clergy member or minister 14 15 shall be required to provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or privileges for a purpose 16 related to the solemnization of any marriage if the action would cause the individual or organization to 17 violate a sincerely held religious belief. 18 B. A refusal to solemnize a marriage or provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or 19 privileges under subsection A shall not give rise to civil or criminal liability or any other action by the 20 Commonwealth or a political subdivision to penalize or withhold benefits or privileges, including tax 21 exemptions or governmental contracts, grants, or licenses, from any individual or organization listed in
