7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

8 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 23-290.2 as follows:**

9 **§ 23-290.2. 400th anniversary of landmark events in Virginia's history; planning, coordination,**
10 **and implementation.**

11 *A. All agencies and institutions of the Commonwealth shall, upon request, designate liaisons and*
12 *provide assistance and advice to the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation for the planning, coordination,*
13 *and implementation of the 400th anniversary of landmark events in Virginia's history in 2019.*

14 *B. With the prior written approval of the Governor, the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation may*
15 *perform the following actions directly relating to the planning, coordination, and implementation of the*
16 *400th anniversary of landmark events in Virginia's history in 2019:*

17 *1. Solicit and accept donations of materials and services to defray expenses;*

18 *2. Retain all nongeneral funds from grants, donations, contributions, gifts, fees, sales, or other funds*
19 *received, collected, or undertaken by the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation for the 400th anniversary*
20 *commemoration. Such nongeneral funds shall be retained and not reverted back to the general fund at*
21 *the end of any fiscal year;*

22 *3. Procure, with the maximum delegated authority available to any executive branch agency or*
23 *institution in the Commonwealth, any goods and services with which there are minimum procurement*
24 *requirements associated;*

25 *4. Hire employees up to the Maximum Employment Level for the Foundation as provided in the*
26 *general appropriations act, despite any potential suspension on hiring that may be mandated for the*
27 *state agencies;*

28 *5. Receive assistance and advice from agencies and institutions of the Commonwealth without*
29 *charge; and*

30 *6. Contact international, national, interstate, state, regional, and local elected and appointed*
31 *officials.*

32 **2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, 2020.**
