That § 2.2-401.01 is of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 2.2-401.01. Liaison to Virginia Indian tribes. A. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall: Serve as the Governor's liaison to the Virginia Indian tribes; and Report annually on the status of Indian tribes in Virginia. B. The Secretary of the Commonwealth may establish a Virginia Indian divisory board to assist the Secretary in reviewing applications seeking recognition as a Virginia Indian tribe and to make recommendations to the Secretary, the Governor, and the General Assembly on such applications and other matters relating to recognition as follows: members of any such board shall be composed of no more than seven members to be appointed by the Secretary consisting of at least three of the members shall represent the Virginia Indian community, and one nonlegislative citizen member shall represent the Commonwealth's scholarly community.
