7 WHEREAS, Vaudene Rose Fable Pedigo of Williamsburg, who touched the lives of thousands of
8 children as a teacher and librarian during a long and productive career in public education and whose
9 zest for life kept her active and engaged, died on September 6, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Vaudene "Viky" Rose Fable Pedigo, who was a native of Louisville, Kentucky, earned a
 bachelor's degree from Butler University and a master's degree from Emory University and was a
 member of several professional organizations; and

WHEREAS, Viky Pedigo started her career in education as a teacher at Matthew Whaley Elementary
School; she became a librarian in 1974 after she had temporarily lost the ability to speak and then
followed her doctors' recommendation to find work that required less talking; and

WHEREAS, Viky Pedigo was an employee of the Williamsburg-James City County Public School
division for 50 years until her retirement in 2015; she was passionate about literature and worked
tirelessly to instill a love of reading in children; and

WHEREAS, Viky Pedigo also was at Rawls Byrd Elementary School for many years and was media
specialist at the school when she retired; additionally, she taught children's literature courses at The
College of William and Mary and assisted young people who were studying for a GED; and

WHEREAS, Viky Pedigo, who enjoyed staying busy and involved, taught English as a Second
 Language; in addition to her many varied cultural interests, she was a summer librarian for the school
 division and also worked with local organizations to encourage literacy; and

WHEREAS, Viky Pedigo will be greatly missed and fondly remembered by her son, Lance; and
many family members, friends, colleagues, and the legions of people who as children developed a love
of the written word due in part to her devoted efforts; now, therefore, be it
