16102162D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 169** 1 2 Offered January 14, 2016 3 Designating May through October, in 2016 and in each succeeding year, as Virginia Barbecue Season. 4 Patrons—Howell, Cole and Sickles 5 6 Referred to Committee on Rules 7 8 WHEREAS, pull tender, mouthwatering, and delicious southern barbecue has a long and illustrious 9 history in Virginia, having first been cooked in the early 17th century through a collaboration between European colonists, Virginia's Native Americans, and African Americans; and 10 WHEREAS, those early Virginians worked together to produce the gift of barbecue, which would 11 become known as one of the "ancient and honorable institutions of Virginia"; and 12 13 WHEREAS, beginning in May of each year, early Virginians entertained family and friends with barbecues and nearly every Saturday there would be a barbecue somewhere in each county until frost 14 15 arrived in October; and WHEREAS, President James Madison, Father of the Constitution, was known to have a well-used 16 17 Virginia barbecue pit on his south lawn where he entertained guests, and President George Washington, the Father of our Country, was very fond of old Virginia barbecue; and 18 19 WHEREAS, these facts demonstrate that barbecue is "essential to any public celebration among the 20 descendants of the Ancient Dominion"; and 21 WHEREAS, Virginians across the Commonwealth still enjoy barbecue to this day on many 22 occasions: and 23 WHEREAS, Virginia barbecue restaurants, eateries, and pit masters have been recognized around the 24 world for their culinary barbecue creations; and 25 WHEREAS, Virginia barbecue is important to state tourism and the economy; and WHEREAS, the people of the Commonwealth extend its famous Old Dominion hospitality and invite 26 27 everyone to enjoy delicious Virginia barbecue; now, therefore, be it 28 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate 29 May through October, in 2016 and in each succeeding year, as Virginia Barbecue Season; and, be it 30 RESOLVED FURTHER, That barbecue lovers are encouraged to celebrate Virginia Barbecue Season 31 by enjoying their favorite barbecue and barbecue establishments throughout the Commonwealth are encouraged to participate in the celebration of Virginia Barbecue Season; and, be it 32 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution 33 34 to Eric Terry, president of the Virginia Restaurant, Lodging, and Travel Association, and Rita D. 35 McClenny, president and CEO of the Virginia Tourism Corporation, so that members of the Virginia 36 Restaurant, Lodging, and Travel Association and the Virginia Tourism Corporation may be apprised of 37 the sense of the General Assembly of Virginia in this matter; and, be it RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates post the designation of this 38 39 declaration and season on the General Assembly's website.
