## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 184

WHEREAS, currently, Jackie Moore is an application systems analyst for the Department of Information Technology for the Chesapeake Public School division; she also has taught school in Ohio, California, and Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Jackie Moore belongs to the Luncheon Pilot Club of Chesapeake and the Great Bridge Battlefield & Waterways History Foundation, has been an ombudsman for the USS *Portland* (LSD-37), and was liaison for the ship's family support group; additionally, she is a member of the Chesapeake Education Association, Virginia Education Association, and National Education Association; and

WHEREAS, as a cake artist, Jackie Moore has provided exquisitely decorated baked goods to help raise money for many organizations in Chesapeake; she also is a writer and hopes to complete her first book, *Ariana's Angels*, in 2016; now, therefore, be it
