9 Bridgewater has doubled in size by expanding its borders and through the responsible development of
10 residential subdivisions, despite economic downturns and reductions in state and federal funds; and

11 WHEREAS, providing steady and effective leadership through natural disasters, Bob Holton has 12 helped Bridgewater endure multiple serious floods, a derecho, and contamination of the North River that 13 affected the town's water supply; and

WHEREAS, Bob Holton motivated his fellow members of local government to work smarter and

 ensure efficiency and consistency; and

 completed internship requirements in Bridgewater and went on to achieve great success in the field of
