Commending the Robinson Secondary School girls' lacrosse team.

WHEREAS, the victory is a testament to the skill and hard work of all of the student-athletes, the able leadership of the coaches and staff, and the enthusiastic support of the entire Robinson Secondary School community; now, therefore, be it
