5 6 WHEREAS, Howard Meredith Campbell of Prospect, a public servant and community leader who 7 served and safeguarded the community as a deputy sheriff and a volunteer firefighter, died on July 8, 8 2014: and

WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Prince Edward County, Howard "Pete" Meredith Campbell graduated from Prince Edward Academy and attended Central Virginia Community College, before 9 10 graduating from the Central Virginia Criminal Justice Academy; and 11

WHEREAS, during a 25-year career in law enforcement, Pete Campbell served as a deputy with the 12 Prince Edward County Sheriff's Office and worked at the Piedmont Regional Jail; and 13

WHEREAS, Pete Campbell safeguarded the lives and property of his fellow residents as a volunteer 14 firefighter with Prospect Volunteer Fire Department, Company 4, for more than 50 years, including as 15 assistant chief and chief; and 16

WHEREAS, while working at Prospect Volunteer Fire Department, Pete Campbell became an expert 17 on the company's water trucks and designed a mini-pumper, which is still in operation after 20 years of 18 19 use; he also headed the company's annual Harvest Sale, which raised thousands of dollars to benefit the 20 community; and
