WHÊREAS, a woman of great integrity, Alfreda Talton-Harris has served the City of Suffolk and the Commonwealth with the utmost professionalism and dedication; after her well-earned retirement, she plans to seek new opportunities to serve the community and spend more time with her husband, Alvin, and their daughters, Aliste and Alexa; now, therefore, be it
