Commending Tony Rice.

WHEREAS, Tony Rice, a Danville native, has made many exceptional contributions to American music as a singer, songwriter, and renowned bluegrass, folk, and jazz guitarist; and

9 WHEREAS, born David Anthony Rice, Tony Rice grew up in Southern California, where he cultivated his appreciation for traditional bluegrass as well as contemporary stylings; and

WHEREAS, following in his father's footsteps as a musician, Tony Rice became a charter member of
 the Bluegrass Alliance, an early contemporary bluegrass group, after relocating to Kentucky in 1970;
 and

WHEREAS, Tony Rice later played with J.D. Crowe and the New South and the David Grisman
 Quintet before forming the Bluegrass Album Band, a supergroup comprising some of the biggest names
 in the genre; and

WHEREAS, Tony Rice highlighted his unique blend of bluegrass and other genres on solo and duet
recordings; recorded two albums with brothers Larry, Ron, and Wyatt; and contributed to *Out of the Woodwork*, an album of traditional bluegrass; and

WHEREAS, a talented multi-instrumentalist, Tony Rice is known for his skill as a guitarist, but is
 also featured on recordings playing drums, piano, soprano sax, and other traditional bluegrass
 instruments; and

WHEREAS, in the course of his celebrated career, Tony Rice earned a Grammy Award for BestCountry Instrumental Performance with J.D. Crowe and the New South and multiple awards from the

International Bluegrass Music Association, including induction into the organization's Hall of Fame;
 now, therefore, be it

28 leader in American music who has delighted countless fans and influenced generations of musicians;
