WHEREAS, Landon Worsham is a long-serving Sunday school superintendent at Chatham
 Presbyterian Church and has overseen the Christian education program for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS, a small-business owner, Landon Worsham has been an active member of the Chatham
Lions Club and the Chatham Jaycees, who honored him with their Spark Plug award in 1959;
additionally, he received the Citizenship Award from the Chatham Chamber of Commerce in 1977; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Landon Worsham was feted by the community for his service to the Chatham
area, including his six decades as a member of the Chatham Volunteer Fire Department; he also
received a national Daily Points of Light Award in 2013; now, therefore, be it
