10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That §§ 2.2-1604 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-1604. Definitions.
13	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
14	"Certification" means the process by which a business is determined to be a small, women-owned, or
15	minority-owned business for the purpose of reporting small, women-owned, and minority-owned
16	business participation in state contracts and purchases pursuant to §§ 2.2-1608 and 2.2-1610.
17	"Department" means the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity or any division of the
18	Department to which the Director has delegated or assigned duties and responsibilities.
19	"Employment services organization" means an organization that provides community-based
20	employment services to individuals with disabilities that is an approved Commission on Accreditation of
21	Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) accredited vendor of the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative
22	Services.
23	"Historically black colleges and university" includes any college or university that was established
24	prior to 1964; whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans; and that is
25	accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary of
26	Education.
27	"Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident
28	alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:
29	1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and
30	who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.
31	2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East,
32	Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China,
33	Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana Islands, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of
34	the Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka, and who is regarded as such by the community of
35	which this person claims to be a part.
36	3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of
37	Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and
38	who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.
39	4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America
40	and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is
41	recognized by a tribal organization.
42	"Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more
43	minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation,
44	partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership
45	interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or
46	more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and
47	daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals, or any historically black
48	college or university, regardless of the percentage ownership by minority individuals or, in the case of a
49	corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, the equity ownership interest in the
50	corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity.
51	"Small business" means a business that is at least 51 percent independently owned and controlled by
52	one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens and, together with affiliates, has
53	250 or fewer employees or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the
54	previous three years meets the small business size standards established by the regulations of the U.S.
55	Small Business Administration. One or more of the individual owners shall control both the management
56	and daily business operations of the small business.

57 "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other
58 unit of state government. "State agency" does not include any county, city, or town.

59 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women 60 who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited 61 liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is owned by one or 62 more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business 63 operations are controlled by one or more women.

§ 2.2-4310. Discrimination prohibited; participation of small, women-owned, minority-owned, 64 and service disabled veteran-owned business. 65

A. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or 66 offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, status as a service disabled 67 veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment. Whenever 68 solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by 69 70 the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity.

71 B. All public bodies shall establish programs consistent with this chapter to facilitate the participation of small businesses and businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans in 72 73 procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in writing and shall comply with the 74 provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection 75 C or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. State agencies shall submit annual 76 77 progress reports on small, women-owned, and minority-owned business procurement and on service 78 disabled veteran-owned business procurement to the Department of Small Business and Supplier 79 Diversity in a form specified by the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity. The Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity shall make information on service disabled 80 veteran-owned procurement available to the Department of Veterans Services upon request. 81

C. Whenever there exists (i) a rational basis for small business enhancement or (ii) a persuasive 82 83 analysis that documents a statistically significant disparity between the availability and utilization of women-owned and minority-owned businesses, the Governor is authorized and encouraged to require 84 state agencies to implement appropriate enhancement or remedial measures consistent with prevailing 85 86 law.

87 D. In awarding a contract for services to a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business that is 88 certified in accordance with § 2.2-1606, or to a business identified by a public body as a service 89 disabled veteran-owned business where the award is being made pursuant to an enhancement or remedial 90 program as provided in subsection C, the public body shall include in every such contract of more than 91 \$10,000 the following:

92 "If the contractor intends to subcontract work as part of its performance under this contract, the 93 contractor shall include in the proposal a plan to subcontract to small, women-owned, minority-owned, 94 and service disabled veteran-owned businesses."

95 E. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no state agency, department or institution shall discriminate against a bidder or offeror because the bidder or offeror employs ex-offenders unless the 96 97 state agency, department or institution has made a written determination that employing ex-offenders on 98 the specific contract is not in its best interest. 99

F. As used in this section:

100 "Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident 101 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

102 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part. 103

2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, 104 Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China, 105 Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana Islands, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of 106 107 the Pacific, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, or Sri Lanka and who is regarded as such by the community of 108 which this person claims to be a part.

109 3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and 110 111 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America 112 and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is 113 114 recognized by a tribal organization.

115 "Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, 116 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership 117 interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and 118 119 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals, or any historically black 120

121 college or university as defined in § 2.2-1604, regardless of the percentage ownership by minority
 122 individuals or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, the
 123 equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity.

124 "Service disabled veteran" means a veteran who (i) served on active duty in the United States
125 military ground, naval, or air service, (ii) was discharged or released under conditions other than
126 dishonorable, and (iii) has a service-connected disability rating fixed by the United States Department of
127 Veterans Affairs.

128 "Service disabled veteran business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or 129 more service disabled veterans or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company 130 or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or 131 limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are service disabled 132 veterans and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more 133 individuals who are service disabled veterans.

"Small business" means a business, independently owned and controlled by one or more individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years meets the small business size standards established by the regulations of the U.S. Small Business Administration. One or more of the individual owners shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small business.

140 "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or other141 unit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town.

142 "Women-owned business" means a business that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women

143 who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited

144 liability company or other entity, at least 51 percent of the equity ownership interest is owned by one or 145 more women who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business

146 operations are controlled by one or more women.
