14	numbered 3.2-6043, as follows:
15 16	§ 3.2-3617. Fund established; disposition of fees, assessments, and penalties. A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Feed,
17	Lime, Fertilizer, and Animal Remedies Fund, hereafter referred to <i>in this section</i> as "the Fund." The
18	Fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. Except as otherwise specified, moneys levied
19	and collected pursuant to this chapter and, pursuant to Chapters 37, 48, and 49, and pursuant to §
20	3.2-6043 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the
21	Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including
22 23	interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the purposes set forth in this chapter.

34 35	Any seller of a newborn cow calf shall certify on a form provided by the Commissioner that the calf received at least four quarts of colostrum during the six hours following its birth. Any seller who
35 36	violates this section may be assessed a civil penalty by the Board in an amount not to exceed \$50 per
37 38	violation. All amounts paid as penalties for violations of this section under shall be paid into the Feed, Lime, Fertilizer, and Animal Remedies Fund, established in § 3.2-3617, to be used in carrying out the
