10	1. That § 58.1-3732.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 58.1-3732.4. Limitation on gross receipts; staffing firms.
13	A. Gross receipts for license tax purposes under this chapter shall not include employee benefits paid
14	by a staffing firm to, or for the benefit of, any contract employee for the period of time that the contract
15	employee is actually employed or working for the use of the client company pursuant to the terms of a
16 17	PEO services contract or temporary help services contract. The taxable gross receipts of a staffing firm shall include any administrative fees received by such firm from a client company, whether on a
18	fee-for-service basis or as a percentage of total receipts from the client company, whether on a
19	B. For the purpose of this section:
20	"Client company" means a person that enters into a contract with a staffing firm by which the
21	staffing firm, for a fee, provides PEO services or temporary help services.
22	"Contract employee" means an employee performing services under a PEO services contract or
23 24	temporary help services contract or independent contractor who receives a Form W-2 or a Form 1099, respectively.
2 4 25	"Employee benefits" means wages, salaries, payroll taxes, payroll deductions, workers' compensation
26	costs, benefits, and similar expenses.
27	"PEO services" or "professional employer organization services" means an arrangement whereby a
28	staffing firm assumes employer responsibility for payroll, benefits, and other human resources functions
29	with respect to employees of a client company with no restrictions or limitations on the duration of
30 31	employment. "PEO services contract" means a contract pursuant to which a staffing firm provides PEO services
32	for a client company.
33	"Staffing firm" means a person that provides PEO services or temporary help services.
34	"Temporary help services" means an arrangement whereby a staffing firm temporarily assigns
35	employees to support or supplement a client company's workforce.
36 37	"Temporary help services contract" means a contract pursuant to which a staffing firm provides
