10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 55-516.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11 12	§ 55-516.2. Condemnation of common area; procedure.
13	When any portion of the common area is taken or damaged under the power of eminent domain, any
14	award or payment therefor shall be paid to the association, which shall be a party in interest in the
15	condemnation proceeding. In valuing the common area that is affected, the factfinder shall take into
16	account all relevant circumstances, including the value of those neighboring properties that hold
17	easements.
18	Except to the extent the declaration or any rules and regulations duly adopted pursuant thereto
19	otherwise provide, the board of directors shall have the authority to negotiate with the condemning
20	authority, agree to an award or payment amount with the condemning authority without instituting
21	condemnation proceedings and, upon such agreement, convey the subject common area to the
22	condemning authority. Thereafter, the president of the association may unilaterally execute and record
23	the deed of conveyance to the condemning authority.
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A member of the association, by virtue of his membership, shall be estopped from contesting the action of the association in any proceeding held pursuant to this section.

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
