8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
ğ	1. That § 53.1-220.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 53.1-220.2. Transfer of certain incarcerated persons to Immigration and Customs
11	Enforcement.
12	A. Any Director, sheriff, or other official in charge of the facility in which an alien is incarcerated
13	who receives any detainer from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement shall not release such alien
14	subject to the detainer except to transfer custody of such alien to another facility or to an appropriate
15	federal authority, provided that no alien may be held in custody in excess of the date that he would
16	otherwise be released from custody. However, if federal or state law requires that such alien be held in
17	custody until transferred to an appropriate federal authority in excess of such date, such alien shall be
18	held in custody in accordance with federal or state law.
19	<i>B.</i> The Director, sheriff, or other official in charge of the facility in which an alien is incarcerated
20	may, upon receipt of a detainer from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, transfer custody of
20 21	the alien to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement no more than five days prior to the date that he

21 22 23 24 would otherwise be released from custody. Upon transfer of custody, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the alien shall receive credit for the number of days remaining before he would

otherwise have been released.
