A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-23 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Superintendent of
Public Instruction; tracking teacher turnover.

Referred to Committee on Education and Health
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
1. That § 22.1-23 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 22.1-23. Duties in general.
The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall:
1. Serve as secretary of the Board of Education;
2. Provide such assistance in his office as shall be necessary for the proper and uniform enforcement
of the provisions of the school laws in cooperation with the local school authorities;
3. Prepare and furnish such forms for attendance officers, teachers and other school officials as are
required by law;
4. (Expires July 1, 2020) At least annually, survey all local school divisions to identify critical
shortages of teachers and administrative personnel by geographic area, by school division, or by subject
matter, and report such critical shortages to each local school division and to the Virginia Retirement
System;
5. Develop and implement a system to track teacher turnover, which may include exit questionnaires,
and annually report his findings to the General Assembly and the Governor;
6. Along with the State Health Commissioner, work to combat childhood obesity and other chronic
health conditions that affect school-age children; 6. 7. Designate an employee of the Department of Education to serve as its liaison to the State

Council of Higher Education for Virginia and the State Board for Community Colleges; and
7. 8. Perform such other duties as the Board of Education may prescribe.
