10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 57-2.03 as follows:
12	§ 57-2.03. Religious freedom; solemnization of marriage.
13	A. No person authorized to perform a marriage ceremony pursuant to Chapter 2 (§ 20-13 et seq.) of
14	Title 20 shall be required to solemnize any marriage, and no religious organization, organization
15	supervised or controlled by or operated in connection with a religious organization, individual employed
16	by a religious organization while acting in the scope of his employment, or clergy member or minister
17	shall be required to provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or privileges for a purpose
18	related to the solemnization of any marriage if the action would cause the individual or organization to
19	violate a sincerely held religious belief.
20	B. A refusal to solemnize a marriage or provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or
21	privileges under subsection A shall not give rise to civil or criminal liability or any other action by the
22	Commonwealth or a political subdivision to penalize or withhold benefits or privileges including tar

23 exemptions or governmental contracts, grants, or licenses, from any individual or organization listed in
24 subsection A.
