30 31	7. A gift, tangible good, chattel, or an interest in a gift, tangible good, or chattel;8. A loan or forgiveness of indebtedness;
31 32	9. A work of art, antique, or collectible;
33	10. An automobile or other means of personal transportation;

46	"Compensation" means:
47	1. An advance, conveyance, forgiveness of indebtedness, deposit, distribution, loan, payment, gift,
48 49	pledge, or transfer of money or anything of value; or 2. A contract, agreement, promise or other obligation for an advance, conveyance, forgiveness of
50	indebtedness, deposit, distribution, loan, payment, gift, pledge, or transfer of money or anything of
51	value, for services rendered or to be rendered.
52	"Compensation" does not mean reimbursement of expenses if the reimbursement does not exceed the
53	amount actually expended for the expenses and it is substantiated by an itemization of expenses.
54 55	"Council" means the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council established in § 30-355.
55 56	"Executive action" means the proposal, drafting, development, consideration, amendment, adoption,
57	approval, promulgation, issuance, modification, rejection, or postponement by an executive agency or
58	official of legislation or executive orders issued by the Governor. "Executive action" includes
59	procurement transactions.

"Executive agency" means an agency, board, commission, or other body in the executive branch of 60 state government. "Executive agency" includes the State Corporation Commission, the Virginia Workers' 61 62 Compensation Commission, and the Virginia Lottery.

65 2. The Lieutenant Governor:

66 3. The Attorney General;

4. Any officer or employee of the office of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Attorney General 67 68 other than a clerical or secretarial employee;

"Expenditure" means:

74 1. A purchase, payment, distribution, loan, forgiveness of a loan or payment of a loan by a third 75 party, advance, deposit, transfer of funds, a promise to make a payment, or a gift of money or anything 76 of value for any purpose;

2. A payment to a lobbyist for salary, fee, reimbursement for expenses, or other purpose by a person 77 78 employing, retaining, or contracting for the services of the lobbyist separately or jointly with other 79 persons;

80 3. A payment in support of or assistance to a lobbyist or the lobbyist's activities, including the direct 81 payment of expenses incurred at the request or suggestion of the lobbyist;

82 4. A payment that directly benefits an executive or legislative official or a member of the official's 83 immediate family:

5. A payment, including compensation, payment, or reimbursement for the services, time, or expenses 84 of an employee for or in connection with direct communication with an executive or legislative official; 85

6. A payment for or in connection with soliciting or urging other persons to enter into direct 86 87 communication with an executive or legislative official; or

7. A payment or reimbursement for categories of expenditures required to be reported pursuant to 88 89 this chapter.

90 "Expenditure" does not mean a campaign contribution properly received and reported pursuant to 91 Chapter 9.3 (§ 24.2-945 et seq.) of Title 24.2.

92 "Fair market value" means the price that a good or service would bring between a willing seller and 93 a willing buyer in the open market after negotiations. If the fair market value cannot be determined, the 94 actual price paid for the good or service shall be given consideration.

95 "Gift" means anything of value, including any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, 96 loan, forbearance, or other item having monetary value, and includes services as well as gifts of 97 transportation, local travel, and lodgings, and meals, whether provided in-kind or by purchase of a 98 ticket, payment in advance, or reimbursement after the expense has been incurred. 99

"Gift" does not mean:

1. Printed informational or promotional material;

2. A gift that is not used and, no later than 60 days after receipt, is returned to the donor or 101 102 delivered to a charitable organization and is not claimed as a charitable contribution for federal income 103 tax purposes; 104

3. A devise or inheritance;

4. A gift of a value of \$50 or less than \$20;

106 5. Any offer of a ticket, coupon, or other admission or pass unless the ticket, coupon, admission, or 107 pass is used:

108 6. Any food or beverages provided to an individual at beverage associated with an event at which 109 the that is accepted or received by an individual is performing official duties related to his public 110 service while in attendance at the event;

7. Any food and beverages received at or registration or attendance fees waived for any event at 111 112 which the individual is a featured speaker, presenter, or lecturer;

8. An unsolicited award of appreciation or recognition in the form of a plaque, trophy, wall 113 114 memento, or similar item that is given in recognition of public, civic, charitable, or professional service;

9. Any gift from an individual's spouse, child, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, or first cousin; a person to 115 116 whom the donee is engaged to be married; the donee's or his spouse's parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, step-parent, step-grandparent, step-grandchild, step-brother, or step-sister; or the donee's 117 118 brother's or sister's spouse;

10. Travel provided to facilitate attendance by a legislator at a regular or special session of the 119 120 General Assembly, a meeting of a legislative committee or commission, or a national conference where attendance is approved by the House or Senate Committee on Rules; or 121

122 11. Travel related to an official meeting of the Commonwealth, its political subdivisions, or any 123 board, commission, authority, or other entity, or any charitable organization established pursuant to 124 § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code affiliated with such entity, to which such person has been 125 appointed or elected or is a member by virtue of his office or employment; 126 12. Any gift, including travel, from a nonpartisan state, regional, national, or international legislative 127 organization, or an affiliated organization of such organization, of which a legislator or an officer or 128 employee of the legislative branch is a member by virtue of his office or employment; or 129 13. Any gift, including travel, from a charitable organization established pursuant to \$501(c)(3) of 130 the Internal Revenue Code to a legislator or an officer or employee of the legislative branch if such 131 organization has been approved by the Joint Rules Committee of the General Assembly to make gifts. 132 "Immediate family" means (i) the spouse and (ii) any other person who resides in the same 133 household as the executive or legislative official and who is a dependent of the official. 134 "Legislative action" means: 135 1. Preparation, research, drafting, introduction, consideration, modification, amendment, approval, 136 passage, enactment, tabling, postponement, defeat, or rejection of a bill, resolution, amendment, motion, 137 report, nomination, appointment, or other matter by the General Assembly or a legislative official; 138 2. Action by the Governor in approving, vetoing, or recommending amendments for a bill passed by 139 the General Assembly; or 140 3. Action by the General Assembly in overriding or sustaining a veto by the Governor, considering 141 amendments recommended by the Governor, or considering, confirming, or rejecting an appointment of 142 the Governor. 143 "Legislative official" means: 144 1. A member or member-elect of the General Assembly; 2. A member of a committee, subcommittee, commission, or other entity established by and 145 146 responsible to the General Assembly or either house of the General Assembly; or 147 3. Persons employed by the General Assembly or an entity established by and responsible to the 148 General Assembly. 149 "Lobbying" means: 150 1. Influencing or attempting to influence executive or legislative action through oral or written 151 communication with an executive or legislative official; or 152 2. Solicitation of others to influence an executive or legislative official. 153 "Lobbying" does not mean: 154 1. Requests for appointments, information on the status of pending executive and legislative actions, 155 or other ministerial contacts if there is no attempt to influence executive or legislative actions; 156 2. Responses to published notices soliciting public comment submitted to the public official 157 designated in the notice to receive the responses; 158 3. The solicitation of an association by its members to influence legislative or executive action; or 159 4. Communications between an association and its members and communications between a principal and its lobbyists. 160 161 "Lobbyist" means: 162 1. An individual who is employed and receives payments, or who contracts for economic 163 consideration, including reimbursement for reasonable travel and living expenses, for the purpose of 164 lobbying; 165 2. An individual who represents an organization, association, or other group for the purpose of 166 lobbying; or 3. A local government employee who lobbies. 167 "Lobbyist's principal" or "principal" means the entity on whose behalf the lobbyist influences or 168 169 attempts to influence executive or legislative action. An organization whose employees conduct lobbying 170 activities on its behalf is both a principal and an employer of the lobbyists. In the case of a coalition or 171 association that employs or retains others to conduct lobbying activities on behalf of its membership, the 172 principal is the coalition or association and not its individual members. 173 "Local government" means: 174 1. Any county, city, town, or other local or regional political subdivision; 175 2. Any school division; 176 3. Any organization or entity that exercises governmental powers that is established pursuant to an 177 interstate compact; or 178 4. Any organization composed of members representing entities listed in subdivisions 1, 2, or 3 of 179 this definition. 180 "Local government employee" means a public employee of a local government. 181 "Person" means an individual, proprietorship, firm, partnership, joint venture, joint stock company,

182 syndicate, business trust, estate, company, corporation, association, club, committee, organization, or

184 "Procurement transaction" means all functions that pertain to obtaining all goods, services, or
 185 construction on behalf of an executive agency, including description of requirements, selection and
 186 solicitation of sources, preparation and award of contract, and all phases of contract administration.

187 "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Commonwealth.

188 "Value" means the actual cost or fair market value of an item or items, whichever is greater. If the fair market value cannot be determined, the actual amount paid for the item or items shall be given consideration.

191 "Widely attended event" means an event at which at least 25 persons have been invited to attend or
192 there is a reasonable expectation that at least 25 persons will attend the event and the event is open to
193 individuals (i) who share a common interest, (ii) who are members of a public, civic, charitable, or
194 professional organization, (iii) who are from a particular industry or profession, or (iv) who represent
195 persons interested in a particular issue.

§ 2.2-426. Lobbyist reporting; penalty.

A. Each lobbyist shall file with the Council a separate semiannual annual report of expenditures,
including gifts, for each principal for whom he lobbies by December 15 for the preceding six-month
period complete through the last day of October and June 15 July 1 for the preceding six-month
12-month period complete through the last day of April.

B. Each principal who expends more than \$500 to employ or compensate multiple lobbyists shall be responsible for filing a consolidated lobbyist report pursuant to this section in any case in which the lobbyists are each exempt under the provisions of subdivision 7 or 8 of § 2.2-420 from the reporting requirements of this section.

206 Council, which shall be substantially similar to the following and shall be accompanied by instructions
207 provided by the Council.

"Advisory agency" means any board, commission, comm

413 "Affiliated business entity relationship" means a relationship, other than a parent-subsidiary 414 relationship, that exists when (i) one business entity has a controlling ownership interest in the other 415 business entity, (ii) a controlling owner in one entity is also a controlling owner in the other entity, or 416 (iii) there is shared management or control between the business entities. Factors that may be considered 417 in determining the existence of an affiliated business entity relationship include that the same person or 418 substantially the same person owns or manages the two entities, there are common or commingled funds 419 or assets, the business entities share the use of the same offices or employees, or otherwise share 420 activities, resources or personnel on a regular basis, or there is otherwise a close working relationship 421 between the entities.

"Business" means a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise,
association, trust or foundation, or any other individual or entity carrying on a business or profession,
whether or not for profit.

"Candidate" means a person who seeks or campaigns for an office of the Commonwealth or one of
its governmental units in a general, primary, or special election and who is qualified to have his name
placed on the ballot for the office. The candidate shall become subject to the provisions of this chapter
upon the filing of a statement of qualification pursuant to § 24.2-501. The State Board of Elections or
general registrar shall notify each such candidate of the provisions of this chapter. Notification made by
the general registrar shall consist of information developed by the State Board of Elections.

"Contract" means any agreement to which a governmental agency is a party, or any agreement on
behalf of a governmental agency that involves the payment of money appropriated by the General
Assembly or a political subdivision, whether or not such agreement is executed in the name of the
Commonwealth, or some political subdivision thereof. "Contract" includes a subcontract only when the
contract of which it is a part is with the officer's or employee's own governmental agency.

436 "Council" means the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council established in **437** § 30-355.

438 "Employee" means all persons employed by a governmental or advisory agency, unless otherwise439 limited by the context of its use.

440 "Financial institution" means any bank, trust company, savings institution, industrial loan association,
441 consumer finance company, credit union, broker-dealer as defined in subsection A of § 13.1-501, or
442 investment company or advisor registered under the federal Investment Advisors Act or Investment
443 Company Act of 1940.

444 "Gift" means any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, loan, forbearance, or other item 445 having monetary value. It includes services as well as gifts of transportation, local travel, and lodgings and meals, whether provided in-kind, or by purchase of a ticket, payment in advance, or reimbursement after the expense has been incurred. "Gift" does not include (i) any offer of a ticket, coupon, or other 446 447 448 admission or pass unless the ticket, coupon, admission, or pass is used; (ii) honorary degrees; (iii) any 449 athletic, merit, or need-based scholarship or any other financial aid awarded by a public or private 450 school, institution of higher education, or other educational program pursuant to such school, institution, 451 or program's financial aid standards and procedures applicable to the general public; (iv) a campaign contribution properly received and reported pursuant to Chapter 9.3 (§ 24.2-945 et seq.) of Title 24.2; 452 453 (v) any gift related to the private profession or occupation of an officer or employee or of a member of his immediate family; (vi) any food or beverages consumed while attending beverage associated with an 454 455 event at which that is accepted or received by the filer is performing official duties related to his public 456 service while in attendance at the event; (vii) food and beverages received at or registration or 457 attendance fees waived for any event at which the filer is a featured speaker, presenter, or lecturer; (viii) 458 unsolicited awards of appreciation or recognition in the form of a plaque, trophy, wall memento, or 459 similar item that is given in recognition of public, civic, charitable, or professional service; (ix) a devise or inheritance; (x) travel disclosed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act (§ 24.2-945 et 460 461 seq.); (xi) travel paid for or provided by the government of the United States, any of its territories, or any state or any political subdivision of such state; (xii) travel provided to facilitate attendance by a 462 463 legislator at a regular or special session of the General Assembly, a meeting of a legislative committee 464 or commission, or a national conference where attendance is approved by the House or Senate 465 Committee on Rules; (xiii) travel related to an official meeting of the Commonwealth, its political 466 subdivisions, or any board, commission, authority, or other entity, or any charitable organization 467 established pursuant to \$501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code affiliated with such entity, to which such person has been appointed or elected or is a member by virtue of his office or employment; or 468 469 (xiv) gifts from relatives or personal friends; (xv) any gift, including travel, from a nonpartisan state, 470 regional, national, or international legislative organization, or an affiliated organization of such 471 organization, of which a legislator or an officer or employee of the legislative branch is a member by virtue of his office or employment; (xvi) any gift, including travel, from a charitable organization 472 473 established pursuant to § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to a legislator or an officer or 474 employee of the legislative branch if such organization has been approved by the Joint Rules Committee

475 of the General Assembly to make gifts; or (xvii) gifts with a value of less than \$20. For the purpose of 476 this definition, "relative" means the donee's spouse, child, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, or first cousin; a 477 person to whom the donee is engaged to be married; the donee's or his spouse's parent, grandparent, 478 grandchild, brother, sister, step-parent, step-grandparent, step-grandchild, step-brother, or step-sister; or 479 the donee's brother's or sister's spouse. For the purpose of this definition, "personal friend" does not 480 include any person that the filer knows or has reason to know is (a) a lobbyist registered pursuant to 481 Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 2.2; (b) a lobbyist's principal as defined in § 2.2-419; 482 (c) for an officer or employee of a local governmental or advisory agency, a person, organization, or 483 business who is a party to or is seeking to become a party to a contract with the local agency of which 484 he is an officer or an employee; or (d) for an officer or employee of a state governmental or advisory 485 agency, a person, organization, or business who is a party to or is seeking to become a party to a 486 contract with the Commonwealth. For purposes of this definition, "person, organization, or business" 487 includes individuals who are officers, directors, or owners of or who have a controlling ownership 488 interest in such organization or business.

489 "Governmental agency" means each component part of the legislative, executive or judicial branches of state and local government, including each office, department, authority, post, commission, 490 491 committee, and each institution or board created by law to exercise some regulatory or sovereign power 492 or duty as distinguished from purely advisory powers or duties. Corporations organized or controlled by 493 the Virginia Retirement System are "governmental agencies" for purposes of this chapter.

494 "Immediate family" means (i) a spouse and (ii) any other person who resides in the same household 495 as the officer or employee and who is a dependent of the officer or employee.

496 "Officer" means any person appointed or elected to any governmental or advisory agency including 497 local school boards, whether or not he receives compensation or other emolument of office. Unless the context requires otherwise, "officer" includes members of the judiciary. "Parent-subsidiary relationship" means a relationship that exists when one corporation directly or 498

499 500 indirectly owns shares possessing more than 50 percent of the voting power of another corporation.

501 "Personal interest" means a financial benefit or liability accruing to an officer or employee or to a 502 member of his immediate family. Such interest shall exist by reason of (i) ownership in a business if the 503 ownership interest exceeds three percent of the total equity of the business; (ii) annual income that 504 exceeds, or may reasonably be anticipated to exceed, \$5,000 from ownership in real or personal property 505 or a business; (iii) salary, other compensation, fringe benefits, or benefits from the use of property, or 506 any combination thereof, paid or provided by a business or governmental agency that exceeds, or may 507 reasonably be anticipated to exceed, \$5,000 annually; (iv) ownership of real or personal property if the 508 interest exceeds \$5,000 in value and excluding ownership in a business, income, or salary, other 509 compensation, fringe benefits or benefits from the use of property; (v) personal liability incurred or 510 assumed on behalf of a business if the liability exceeds three percent of the asset value of the business; 511 or (vi) an option for ownership of a business or real or personal property if the ownership interest will 512 consist of clause (i) or (iv) above.

513 "Personal interest in a contract" means a personal interest that an officer or employee has in a 514 contract with a governmental agency, whether due to his being a party to the contract or due to a personal interest in a business that is a party to the contract. 515

516 "Personal interest in a transaction" means a personal interest of an officer or employee in any matter 517 considered by his agency. Such personal interest exists when an officer or employee or a member of his 518 immediate family has a personal interest in property or a business or governmental agency, or represents 519 or provides services to any individual or business and such property, business or represented or served 520 individual or business (i) is the subject of the transaction or (ii) may realize a reasonably foreseeable 521 direct or indirect benefit or detriment as a result of the action of the agency considering the transaction. 522 Notwithstanding the above, such personal interest in a transaction shall not be deemed to exist where (a) 523 an elected member of a local governing body serves without remuneration as a member of the board of 524 trustees of a not-for-profit entity and such elected member or member of his immediate family has no 525 personal interest related to the not-for-profit entity or (b) an officer, employee, or elected member of a 526 local governing body is appointed by such local governing body to serve on a governmental agency, or 527 an officer, employee, or elected member of a separate local governmental agency formed by a local 528 governing body is appointed to serve on a governmental agency, and the personal interest in the 529 transaction of the governmental agency is the result of the salary, other compensation, fringe benefits, or 530 benefits provided by the local governing body or the separate governmental agency to the officer, 531 employee, elected member, or member of his immediate family.

532 "State and local government officers and employees" shall not include members of the General 533 Assembly.

534 "State filer" means those officers and employees required to file a disclosure statement of their 535 personal interests pursuant to subsection A or B of § 2.2-3114.

536 "Transaction" means any matter considered by any governmental or advisory agency, whether in a 537 committee, subcommittee, or other entity of that agency or before the agency itself, on which official 538 action is taken or contemplated. 539

§ 2.2-3103.1. Certain gifts prohibited.

A. For purposes of this section:

541 "Person, organization, or business" includes individuals who are officers, directors, or owners of or 542 who have a controlling ownership interest in such organization or business.

543 Widely attended event" means an event at which at least 25 persons have been invited to attend or 544 there is a reasonable expectation that at least 25 persons will attend the event and the event is open to 545 individuals (i) who share a common interest, (ii) who are members of a public, civic, charitable, or 546 professional organization, (iii) who are from a particular industry or profession, or (iv) who represent 547 persons interested in a particular issue.

548 B. No officer or employee of a local governmental or advisory agency or candidate required to file 549 the disclosure form prescribed in § 2.2-3117 or a member of his immediate family shall solicit, accept, 550 or receive any single gift with a value in excess of \$100 or any combination of gifts with an aggregate 551 value in excess of \$100 within any calendar year for himself or a member of his immediate family from 552 any person that he or a member of his immediate family knows or has reason to know is (i) a lobbyist 553 registered pursuant to Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4; (ii) a lobbyist's principal as defined in 554 § 2.2-419; or (iii) a person, organization, or business who is or is seeking to become a party to a 555 contract with the local agency of which he is an officer or an employee. Gifts with a value of less than 556 \$20 are not subject to aggregation for purposes of this prohibition.

557 C. No officer or employee of a state governmental or advisory agency or candidate required to file the disclosure form prescribed in § 2.2-3117 or a member of his immediate family shall solicit, accept, 558 559 or receive any single gift with a value in excess of \$100 or any combination of gifts with an aggregate 560 value in excess of \$100 within any calendar year for himself or a member of his immediate family from any person that he or a member of his immediate family knows or has reason to know is (i) a lobbyist 561 562 registered pursuant to Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4; (ii) a lobbyist's principal as defined in § 2.2-419; or (iii) a person, organization, or business who is or is seeking to become a party to a 563 564 contract with the state governmental or advisory agency of which he is an officer or an employee or over which he has the authority to direct such agency's activities. Gifts with a value of less than \$20 are 565 566 not subject to aggregation for purposes of this prohibition.

567 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections B and C, such officer, employee, or candidate or a 568 member of his immediate family may accept or receive a gift of food and beverages, entertainment, or 569 the cost of admission with a value in excess of \$100 when such gift is accepted or received while in 570 attendance at a widely attended event and is associated with the event. Such gifts shall be reported on 571 the disclosure form prescribed in § 2.2-3117.

572 E. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections B and C, such officer or employee or a member of 573 his immediate family may accept or receive a gift from a foreign dignitary with a value exceeding \$100 574 for which the fair market value or a gift of greater or equal value has not been provided or exchanged. Such gift shall be accepted on behalf of the Commonwealth or a locality and archived in accordance 575 576 with guidelines established by the Library of Virginia. Such gift shall be disclosed as having been accepted on behalf of the Commonwealth or a locality, but the value of such gift shall not be required 577 578 to be disclosed.

579 F. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections B and C, such officer, employee, or candidate or a 580 member of his immediate family may accept or receive certain gifts with a value in excess of \$100 from a person listed in subsection B or C if such gift was provided to such officer, employee, or candidate or 581 a member of his immediate family on the basis of a personal friendship. Notwithstanding any other 582 provision of law, a person listed in subsection B or C may be a personal friend of such officer, employee, or candidate or his immediate family for purposes of this subsection. In determining whether 583 584 585 a person listed in subsection B or C is a personal friend, the following factors shall be considered: (i) 586 the circumstances under which the gift was offered; (ii) the history of the relationship between the 587 person and the donor, including the nature and length of the friendship and any previous exchange of 588 gifts between them; (iii) to the extent known to the person, whether the donor personally paid for the 589 gift or sought a tax deduction or business reimbursement for the gift; and (iv) whether the donor has 590 given the same or similar gifts to other persons required to file the disclosure form prescribed in 591 § 2.2-3117 or 30-111.

592 G. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections B and C, such officer, employee, or candidate or a 593 member of his immediate family may accept or receive gifts of travel, including travel-related 594 transportation, lodging, hospitality, food or beverages, or other thing of value, with a value in excess of 595 \$100 that is paid for or provided by a person listed in subsection B or C when the officer, employee, or 596 candidate has submitted a request for approval of such travel to the Council and has received the approval of the Council pursuant to § 30-356.1. Such gifts shall be reported on the disclosure form 597

598 prescribed in § 2.2-3117.

599 H. During the pendency of a civil action in any state or federal court to which the Commonwealth is 600 a party, the Governor or the Attorney General or any employee of the Governor or the Attorney General who is subject to the provisions of this chapter shall not solicit, accept, or receive any gift from any 601 602 person that he knows or has reason to know is a person, organization, or business that is a party to such 603 civil action. A person, organization, or business that is a party to such civil action shall not knowingly 604 give any gift to the Governor or the Attorney General or any of their employees who are subject to the 605 provisions of this chapter.

606 I. The \$100 limitation imposed in accordance with this section shall be adjusted by the Council every 607 five years, as of January 1 of that year, in an amount equal to the annual increases for that five-year 608 period in the United States Average Consumer Price Index for all items, all urban consumers (CPI-U), 609 as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor, rounded to the nearest 610 whole dollar.

§ 2.2-3106. Prohibited contracts by officers and employees of state government and Eastern 611 612 Virginia Medical School.

A. No officer or employee of any governmental agency of state government or Eastern Virginia 613 614 Medical School shall have a personal interest in a contract with the governmental agency of which he is 615 an officer or employee, other than his own contract of employment.

616 B. No officer or employee of any governmental agency of state government or Eastern Virginia Medical School shall have a personal interest in a contract with any other governmental agency of state 617 618 government unless such contract is (i) awarded as a result of competitive sealed bidding or competitive 619 negotiation as set forth in § 2.2-4302.1 or 2.2-4302.2 or (ii) is awarded after a finding, in writing, by the 620 administrative head of the governmental agency that competitive bidding or negotiation is contrary to the 621 best interest of the public. 622

C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:

1. An employee's personal interest in additional contracts of employment with his own governmental 623 624 agency that accrue to him because of a member of his immediate family, provided the employee does 625 not exercise any control over the employment or the employment activities of the member of his 626 immediate family and the employee is not in a position to influence those activities;

627 2. The personal interest of an officer or employee of a state institution of higher education or the 628 Eastern Virginia Medical School in additional contracts of employment with his own governmental 629 agency that accrue to him because of a member of his immediate family, provided (i) the officer or 630 employee and the immediate family member are engaged in teaching, research or administrative support 631 positions at the educational institution or the Eastern Virginia Medical School, (ii) the governing board 632 of the educational institution finds that it is in the best interests of the institution or the Eastern Virginia 633 Medical School and the Commonwealth for such dual employment to exist, and (iii) after such finding, 634 the governing board of the educational institution or the Eastern Virginia Medical School ensures that 635 the officer or employee, or the immediate family member, does not have sole authority to supervise, 636 evaluate or make personnel decisions regarding the other;

637 3. An officer's or employee's personal interest in a contract of employment with any other 638 governmental agency of state government;

639 4. Contracts for the sale by a governmental agency or the Eastern Virginia Medical School of 640 services or goods at uniform prices available to the general public;

641 5. An employee's personal interest in a contract between a public institution of higher education in 642 Virginia or the Eastern Virginia Medical School and a publisher or wholesaler of textbooks or other 643 educational materials for students, which accrues to him solely because he has authored or otherwise 644 created such textbooks or materials;

645 6. An employee's personal interest in a contract with his or her employing public institution of higher 646 education to acquire the collections or scholarly works owned by the employee, including manuscripts, 647 musical scores, poetry, paintings, books or other materials, writings, or papers of an academic, research, 648 or cultural value to the institution, provided the president of the institution approves the acquisition of such collections or scholarly works as being in the best interests of the institution's public mission of 649 650 service, research, or education;

651 7. Subject to approval by the board of visitors, an employee's personal interest in a contract between 652 the Eastern Virginia Medical School or a public institution of higher education in Virginia that operates a school of medicine or dentistry and a not-for-profit nonstock corporation that operates a clinical 653 654 practice within such public institution of higher education or the Eastern Virginia Medical School and of 655 which such employee is a member or employee;

656 8. Subject to approval by the relevant board of visitors, an employee's personal interest in a contract 657 for research and development or commercialization of intellectual property between a public institution of higher education in Virginia or the Eastern Virginia Medical School and a business in which the 658

659 employee has a personal interest, if (i) the employee's personal interest has been disclosed to and 660 approved by such public institution of higher education or the Eastern Virginia Medical School prior to the time at which the contract is entered into; (ii) the employee promptly files a disclosure statement **661** pursuant to § 2.2-3117 and thereafter files such statement annually on or before December January 15; **662** (iii) the institution has established a formal policy regarding such contracts, approved by the State 663 **664** Council of Higher Education or, in the case of the Eastern Virginia Medical School, a formal policy 665 regarding such contracts in conformity with any applicable federal regulations that has been approved by its board of visitors; and (iv) no later than December 31 of each year, the institution or the Eastern 666 Virginia Medical School files an annual report with the Secretary of the Commonwealth disclosing each 667 668 open contract entered into subject to this provision, the names of the parties to each contract, the date each contract was executed and its term, the subject of each contractual arrangement, the nature of the 669 conflict of interest, the institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's employee responsible for 670 administering each contract, the details of the institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's 671 672 commitment or investment of resources or finances for each contract, and any other information requested by the Secretary of the Commonwealth; or 673

674 9. Subject to approval by the relevant board of visitors, an employee's personal interest in a contract 675 between a public institution of higher education in Virginia or the Eastern Virginia Medical School and 676 a business in which the employee has a personal interest, if (i) the personal interest has been disclosed 677 to the institution or the Eastern Virginia Medical School prior to the time the contract is entered into; (ii) the employee files a disclosure statement pursuant to § 2.2-3117 and thereafter annually on or before 678 679 December January 15; (iii) the employee does not participate in the institution's or the Eastern Virginia 680 Medical School's decision to contract; (iv) the president of the institution or the Eastern Virginia **681** Medical School finds and certifies in writing that the contract is for goods and services needed for quality patient care, including related medical education or research, by the institution's medical center **682** 683 or the Eastern Virginia Medical School, its affiliated teaching hospitals and other organizations necessary **684** for the fulfillment of its mission, including the acquisition of drugs, therapies and medical technologies; 685 and (v) no later than December 31 of each year, the institution or the Eastern Virginia Medical School **686** files an annual report with the Secretary of the Commonwealth disclosing each open contract entered subject to this provision, the names of the parties to each contract, the date each contract was executed **687** 688 and its term, the subject of each contractual arrangement, the nature of the conflict of interest, the 689 institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's employee responsible for administering each 690 contract, the details of the institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's commitment or 691 investment of resources or finances for each contract, and any other information requested by the 692 Secretary of the Commonwealth.

693 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivisions C 8 and C 9, if the research and development or **694** commercialization of intellectual property or the employee's personal interest in a contract with a 695 business is subject to policies and regulations governing conflicts of interest promulgated by any agency of the United States government, including the adoption of policies requiring the disclosure and 696 697 management of such conflicts of interests, the policies established by the Eastern Virginia Medical **698** School pursuant to such federal requirements shall constitute compliance with subdivisions C 8 and C 9, 699 upon notification by the Eastern Virginia Medical School to the Secretary of the Commonwealth by 700 January 31 of each year of evidence of their compliance with such federal policies and regulations.

701 E. The board of visitors may delegate the authority granted under subdivision C 8 to the president of the institution. If the board elects to delegate such authority, the board shall include this delegation of 702 703 authority in the formal policy required by clause (iii) of subdivision C 8. In those instances where the 704 board has delegated such authority, on or before December 1 of each year, the president of the relevant 705 institution shall file a report with the relevant board of visitors disclosing each open contract entered 706 into subject to this provision, the names of the parties to each contract, the date each contract was 707 executed and its term, the subject of each contractual arrangement, the nature of the conflict of interest, 708 the institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's employee responsible for administering each 709 contract, the details of the institution's or the Eastern Virginia Medical School's commitment or 710 investment of resources or finances for each contract, the details of how revenues are to be dispersed, 711 and any other information requested by the board of visitors.

§ 2.2-3109.1. Prohibited contracts; additional exclusions for contracts by officers and employees 712 713 of hospital authorities.

714 A. As used in this section, "hospital authority" means a hospital authority established pursuant to Chapter 53 (§ 15.2-5300 et seq.) of Title 15.2 or an Act of Assembly. 715 716

 \hat{B} . The provisions of § 2.2-3109 shall not apply to:

717 1. The personal interest of an officer or employee of a hospital authority in additional contracts of 718 employment with his own governmental agency that accrue to him because of a member of his immediate family, provided (i) the officer or employee and the immediate family member are licensed 719 720 members of the medical profession or hold administrative support positions at the hospital authority, (ii)

726 2. Subject to approval by the governing board of the hospital authority, an officer or employee's

729 employee is a member or employee;

730 3. Subject to approval by the relevant governing body, an officer or employee's personal interest in a 731 contract for research and development or commercialization of intellectual property between the hospital 732 authority and a business in which the employee has a personal interest, provided (i) the officer or 733 employee's personal interest has been disclosed to and approved by the hospital authority prior to the 734 time at which the contract is entered into; (ii) the officer or employee promptly files a disclosure 735 statement pursuant to § 2.2-3117 and thereafter files such statement annually on or before December 736 January 15; (iii) the local hospital authority has established a formal policy regarding such contracts in 737 conformity with any applicable federal regulations that has been approved by its governing body; and 738 (iv) no later than December 31 of each year, the local hospital authority files an annual report with the 739 Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council disclosing each open contract entered into 740 subject to this provision, the names of the parties to each contract, the date each contract was executed 741 and its term, the subject of each contractual arrangement, the nature of the conflict of interest, the 742 hospital authority's employee responsible for administering each contract, the details of such hospital 743 authority's commitment or investment of resources or finances for each contract, and any other 744 information requested by the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council; or

745 4. Subject to approval by the relevant governing body, an officer or employee's personal interest in a 746 contract between the hospital authority and a business in which the officer or employee has a personal 747 interest, provided (i) the personal interest has been disclosed to the hospital authority prior to the time 748 the contract is entered into; (ii) the officer or employee files a disclosure statement pursuant to 749 § 2.2-3117 and thereafter annually on or before December January 15; (iii) the officer or employee does 750 not participate in the hospital authority's decision to contract; (iv) the president or chief executive officer 751 of the hospital authority finds and certifies in writing that the contract is for goods and services needed 752 for quality patient care, including related medical education or research, by any of the hospital 753 authority's medical facilities or any of its affiliated organizations, or is otherwise necessary for the 754 fulfillment of its mission, including but not limited to the acquisition of drugs, therapies, and medical 755 technologies; and (v) no later than December 31 of each year, the hospital authority files an annual report with the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council disclosing each open contract 756 757 entered into subject to this provision, the names of the parties to each contract, the date each contract 758 was executed and its term, the subject of each contractual arrangement, the nature of the conflict of 759 interest, the hospital authority's employee responsible for administering each contract, the details of the 760 hospital authority's commitment or investment of resources or finances for each contract, and any other 761 information requested by the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council.

762 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivisions B 3 and B 4, if the research and development or 763 commercialization of intellectual property or the officer or employee's personal interest in a contract with a business is subject to policies and regulations governing conflicts of interest promulgated by any 764 765 agency of the United States government, including the adoption of policies requiring the disclosure and 766 management of such conflicts of interest, the policies established by the hospital authority pursuant to 767 such federal requirements shall constitute compliance with subdivisions B 3 and B 4, upon notification by the hospital authority to the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council by January 31 768 769 of each year of evidence of its compliance with such federal policies and regulations.

770 D. The governing body may delegate the authority granted under subdivision B 2 to the president or 771 chief executive officer of hospital authority. When the filing deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the disclosure statement shall be filed on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, 803 or legal holiday. 826 F. An officer or employee of state government who is required to declare his interest pursuant to 827 subdivision A 2 of § 2.2-3112, shall declare his interest by stating (i) the transaction involved, (ii) the nature of the officer's or employee's personal interest affected by the transaction, (iii) that he is a 828 829 member of a business, profession, occupation, or group the members of which are affected by the 830 transaction, and (iv) that he is able to participate in the transaction fairly, objectively, and in the public 831 interest. The officer or employee shall either make his declaration orally to be recorded in written 832 minutes for his agency or file a signed written declaration with the clerk or administrative head of his 833 governmental or advisory agency, as appropriate, who shall, in either case, retain and make available for 834 public inspection such declaration for a period of five years from the date of recording or receipt. If 835 reasonable time is not available to comply with the provisions of this subsection prior to participation in 836 the transaction, the officer or employee shall prepare and file the required declaration by the end of the 837 next business day.

G. An officer or employee of state government who is required to declare his interest pursuant to
subdivision A 3 of § 2.2-3112, shall declare his interest by stating (i) the transaction involved, (ii) that a
party to the transaction is a client of his firm, (iii) that he does not personally represent or provide
services to the client, and (iv) that he is able to participate in the transaction fairly, objectively, and in
the public interest. The officer or employee shall either make his declaration orally to be recorded in
written minutes for his agency or file a signed written declaration with the clerk or administrative head

876 Persons occupying such positions of trust appointed by governing bodies and persons occupying such 877 positions of employment with governing bodies as may be designated to file by ordinance of the 878 governing body shall file, as a condition to assuming office or employment, a disclosure statement of 879 their personal interests and other information as is specified on the form set forth in § 2.2-3117 and 880 thereafter shall file such a statement semiannually by December annually on or before January 15 for 881 the preceding six-month period complete through the last day of October and by June 15 for the 882 preceding six-month period complete through the last day of April.

883 Persons occupying such positions of trust appointed by school boards and persons occupying such **884** positions of employment with school boards as may be designated to file by an adopted policy of the 885 school board shall file, as a condition to assuming office or employment, a disclosure statement of their 886 personal interests and other information as is specified on the form set forth in § 2.2-3117 and thereafter 887 shall file such a statement semiannually by December annually on or before January 15 for the 888 preceding six-month period complete through the last day of October and by June 15 for the preceding 889 six-month period complete through the last day of April.

890 B. Nonsalaried citizen members of local boards, commissions and councils as may be designated by 891 the governing body shall file, as a condition to assuming office, a disclosure form of their personal 892 interests and such other information as is specified on the form set forth in § 2.2-3118 and thereafter 893 shall file such form annually on or before December January 15.

C. No person shall be mandated to file any disclosure not otherwise required by this article.

1496 "Advisory agency" means any board, commission, committee or post which does not exercise any sovereign power or duty, but is appointed by a governmental agency or officer or is created by law for the purpose of making studies or recommendations, or advising or consulting with a governmental agency.

1500 "Business" means a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise,
1501 association, trust or foundation, or any other individual or entity carrying on a business or profession,
1502 whether or not for profit.

"Candidate" means a person who seeks or campaigns for election to the General Assembly in a general, primary, or special election and who is qualified to have his name placed on the ballot for the office. The candidate shall become subject to the provisions of this section upon the filing of a statement of qualification pursuant to § 24.2-501. The State Board of Elections shall notify each such candidate of the provisions of this chapter.

"Contract" means any agreement to which a governmental agency is a party, or any agreement on
behalf of a governmental agency that involves the payment of money appropriated by the General
Assembly or a political subdivision, whether or not such agreement is executed in the name of the
Commonwealth, or some political subdivision thereof. "Contract" includes a subcontract only when the
contract of which it is a part is with the legislator's own governmental agency.

1513 "Council" means the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council established in **1514** § 30-355.

1515 "Financial institution" means any bank, trust company, savings institution, industrial loan association,
1516 consumer finance company, credit union, broker-dealer as defined in subsection A of § 13.1-501, or
1517 investment company or advisor registered under the federal Investment Advisors Act or Investment
1518 Company Act of 1940.

1519 "Gift" means any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, loan, forbearance, or other item 1520 having monetary value. It includes services as well as gifts of transportation, and lodgings and meals, whether provided in-kind, or by purchase of a ticket, payment in advance, or reimbursement after the expense has been incurred. "Gift" does not include (i) any offer of a ticket, coupon, or other admission 1521 1522 or pass unless the ticket, coupon, admission, or pass is used; (ii) honorary degrees; (iii) any athletic, 1523 1524 merit, or need-based scholarship or any other financial aid awarded by a public or private school, 1525 institution of higher education, or other educational program pursuant to such school, institution, or 1526 program's financial aid standards and procedures applicable to the general public; (iv) a campaign 1527 contribution properly received and reported pursuant to Chapter 9.3 (§ 24.2-945 et seq.) of Title 24.2; 1528 (v) any gift related to the private profession or occupation of a legislator or of a member of his 1529 immediate family; (vi) any food or beverages consumed while attending beverage associated with an 1530 event at which that is accepted or received by the filer is performing official duties related to his public 1531 service while in attendance at the event; (vii) food and beverages received at or registration or 1532 attendance fees waived for any event at which the filer is a featured speaker, presenter, or lecturer; (viii) 1533 unsolicited awards of appreciation or recognition in the form of a plaque, trophy, wall memento, or 1534 similar item that is given in recognition of public, civic, charitable, or professional service; (ix) a devise 1535 or inheritance; (x) travel disclosed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act (§ 24.2-945 et 1536 seq.); (xi) travel paid for or provided by the government of the United States, any of its territories, or 1537 any state or any political subdivision of such state; (xii) travel provided to facilitate attendance by a 1538 legislator at a regular or special session of the General Assembly, a meeting of a legislative committee 1539 or commission, or a national conference where attendance is approved by the House or Senate 1540 Committee on Rules; (xiii) travel related to an official meeting of the Commonwealth, its political 1541 subdivisions, or any board, commission, authority, or other entity, or any charitable organization established pursuant to § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code affiliated with such entity, to which 1542 1543 such person has been appointed or elected or is a member by virtue of his office or employment; or 1544 (xiv) gifts from relatives or personal friends; (xv) any gift, including travel, from a nonpartisan state, 1545 regional, national, or international legislative organization, or an affiliated organization of such 1546 organization, of which a legislator or an officer or employee of the legislative branch is a member by virtue of his office or employment; (xvi) any gift, including travel, from a charitable organization 1547 established pursuant to § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to a legislator or an officer or 1548 1549 employee of the legislative branch if such organization has been approved by the Joint Rules Committee 1550 of the General Assembly to make gifts; or (xvii) gifts with a value of less than \$20. For the purpose of 1551 this definition, "relative" means the donee's spouse, child, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, or first cousin; a 1552 person to whom the donee is engaged to be married; the donee's or his spouse's parent, grandparent, 1553 grandchild, brother, sister, step-parent, step-grandparent, step-grandchild, step-brother, or step-sister; or 1554 the donee's brother's or sister's spouse. For the purpose of this definition, "personal friend" does not 1555 include any person that the filer knows or has reason to know is (a) a lobbyist registered pursuant to 1556 Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 2.2 or (b) a lobbyist's principal as defined in 1557 § 2.2-419.

1558 "Governmental agency" means each component part of the legislative, executive or judicial branches
1559 of state and local government, including each office, department, authority, post, commission, committee, and each institution or board created by law to exercise some regulatory or sovereign power
1561 or duty as distinguished from purely advisory powers or duties.

1562 "Immediate family" means (i) a spouse and (ii) any other person who resides in the same household1563 as the legislator and who is a dependent of the legislator.

1564 "Legislator" means a member of the General Assembly.

1565 "Personal interest" means a financial benefit or liability accruing to a legislator or to a member of his 1566 immediate family. Such interest shall exist by reason of (i) ownership in a business if the ownership 1567 interest exceeds three percent of the total equity of the business; (ii) annual income that exceeds, or may 1568 reasonably be anticipated to exceed, \$5,000 from ownership in real or personal property or a business; 1569 (iii) salary, other compensation, fringe benefits, or benefits from the use of property, or any combination 1570 thereof, paid or provided by a business or governmental agency that exceeds, or may reasonably be 1571 anticipated to exceed, \$5,000 annually; (iv) ownership of real or personal property if the interest exceeds 1572 \$5,000 in value and excluding ownership in a business, income, or salary, other compensation, fringe 1573 benefits or benefits from the use of property; (v) personal liability incurred or assumed on behalf of a business if the liability exceeds three percent of the asset value of the business; or (vi) an option for 1574 1575 ownership of a business or real or personal property if the ownership interest will consist of clause (i) or 1576 (iv).

1577 "Personal interest in a contract" means a personal interest that a legislator has in a contract with a governmental agency, whether due to his being a party to the contract or due to a personal interest in a business that is a party to the contract.

1580 "Personal interest in a transaction" means a personal interest of a legislator in any matter considered 1581 by the General Assembly. Such personal interest exists when an officer or employee or a member of his 1582 immediate family has a personal interest in property or a business, or represents or provides services to any individual or business and such property, business or represented or served individual or business (i) 1583 1584 is the subject of the transaction or (ii) may realize a reasonably foreseeable direct or indirect benefit or 1585 detriment as a result of the action of the agency considering the transaction. A "personal interest in a 1586 transaction" exists only if the legislator or member of his immediate family or an individual or business 1587 represented or served by the legislator is affected in a way that is substantially different from the general 1588 public or from persons comprising a profession, occupation, trade, business or other comparable and 1589 generally recognizable class or group of which he or the individual or business he represents or serves is 1590 a member.

1591 "Transaction" means any matter considered by the General Assembly, whether in a committee,
 1592 subcommittee, or other entity of the General Assembly or before the General Assembly itself, on which
 1593 official action is taken or contemplated.

1594 § 30-103.1. Certain gifts prohibited.

1595 A. For purposes of this section:

"Widely attended event" means an event at which at least 25 persons have been invited to attend or
there is a reasonable expectation that at least 25 persons will attend the event and the event is open to
individuals (i) who share a common interest, (ii) who are members of a public, civic, charitable, or
professional organization, (iii) who are from a particular industry or profession, or (iv) who represent
persons interested in a particular issue.

1601 B. No legislator or candidate for the General Assembly required to file the disclosure form prescribed 1602 in § 30-111 or a member of his immediate family shall solicit, accept, or receive any single gift for 1603 himself or a member of his immediate family with a value in excess of \$100 or any combination of 1604 gifts with an aggregate value in excess of \$100 within any calendar year for himself or a member of his 1605 immediate family from any person that he or a member of his immediate family knows or has reason to 1606 know is (i) a lobbyist registered pursuant to Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 2.2 or (ii) 1607 a lobbyist's principal as defined in § 2.2-419. Gifts with a value of less than \$20 are not subject to 1608 aggregation for purposes of this prohibition.

1609 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection B, a legislator or candidate or a member of his 1610 immediate family may accept or receive a gift of food and beverages, entertainment, or the cost of 1611 admission with a value in excess in \$100 when such gift is accepted or received while in attendance at a 1612 widely attended event and is associated with the event. Such gifts shall be reported on the disclosure 1613 form prescribed in § 30-111.

1614 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection B, a legislator or a member of his immediate family 1615 may accept or receive a gift from a foreign dignitary with a value exceeding \$100 for which the fair 1616 market value or a gift of greater or equal value has not been provided or exchanged. Such gift shall be 1617 accepted on behalf of the Commonwealth and archived in accordance with guidelines established by the 1618 Library of Virginia. Such gift shall be disclosed as having been accepted on behalf of the 1619 Commonwealth, but the value of such gift shall not be required to be disclosed.

1620 E. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection B, a legislator or candidate or a member of his 1621 immediate family may accept or receive certain gifts with a value in excess of \$100 from a person listed 1622 in subsection B if such gift was provided to the legislator or candidate or a member of his immediate 1623 family on the basis of a personal friendship. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person listed 1624 in subsection B may be a personal friend of the legislator or candidate or his immediate family for 1625 purposes of this subsection. In determining whether a person listed in subsection B is a personal friend, 1626 the following factors shall be considered: (i) the circumstances under which the gift was offered; (ii) the history of the relationship between the person and the donor, including the nature and length of the 1627 1628 friendship and any previous exchange of gifts between them; (iii) to the extent known to the person, 1629 whether the donor personally paid for the gift or sought a tax deduction or business reimbursement for the gift; and (iv) whether the donor has given the same or similar gifts to other persons required to file 1630 the disclosure form prescribed in § 2.2-3117 or 30-111. 1631

1632 F. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection B, a legislator or candidate or a member of his 1633 immediate family may accept or receive gifts of travel, including travel-related transportation, lodging, hospitality, food or beverages, or other thing of value, with a value in excess of \$100 that is paid for or 1634 1635 provided by a person listed in subsection B when the legislator or candidate has submitted a request for approval of such travel to the Council and has received the approval of the Council pursuant to 1636 1637 § 30-356.1. Such gifts shall be reported on the disclosure form prescribed in § 30-111.

1638 G. The \$100 limitation imposed in accordance with this section shall be adjusted by the Council 1639 every five years, as of January 1 of that year, in an amount equal to the annual increases for that 1640 five-year period in the United States Average Consumer Price Index for all items, all urban consumers 1641 (CPI-U), as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor, rounded to the 1642 nearest whole dollar. 1643

§ 30-110. Disclosure.

(Effective January 1, 2016, through July 1, 2016) Every legislator and legislator-elect shall file, as 1645 a condition to assuming office, a disclosure statement of his personal interests and such other information as is specified on the form set forth in § 30-111 and thereafter shall file such a statement 1646 1647 semiannually by December annually on or before January 15 for the preceding six-month period complete through the last day of October and by June 15 for the preceding six-month period complete 1648 1649 through the last day of April. When the filing deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the 1650 disclosure statement shall be filed on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. Disclosure forms shall be made available by the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory 1651 Council at least 30 days prior to the filing deadline. Members of the Senate and members of the House 1652 1653 of Delegates shall file their disclosure forms with the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council. The disclosure forms of the members of the General Assembly shall be maintained as public 1654 1655 records for five years in the office of the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council. Such forms shall be made public no later than six weeks after filing. 1656

A. (Effective July 1, 2016) Every legislator and legislator-elect shall file, as a condition to assuming 1657 1658 office, a disclosure statement of his personal interests and such other information as is specified on the 1659 form set forth in § 30-111 and thereafter shall file such a statement semiannually by December annually 1660 on or before January 15 for the preceding six-month period complete through the last day of October 1661 and by June 15 for the preceding six month period complete through the last day of April. When the 1662 filing deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the disclosure statement shall be filed on 1663 the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. Disclosure forms shall be made available 1664 by the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council at least 30 days prior to the filing 1665 deadline. Disclosure forms shall be filed electronically with the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics 1666 Advisory Council in accordance with the standards approved by it pursuant to § 30-356. The disclosure forms of the members of the General Assembly shall be maintained as public records for five years in 1667 the office of the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council. Such forms shall be made 1668 1669 public no later than six weeks after filing.

B. Candidates for the General Assembly shall file a disclosure statement of their personal interests as 1670 1671 required by §§ 24.2-500 through 24.2-503.

1672 C. Any legislator who has a personal interest in any transaction pending before the General 1673 Assembly and who is disqualified from participating in that transaction pursuant to § 30-108 and the 1674 rules of his house shall disclose his interest in accordance with the applicable rule of his house. 1675

For purposes of this section, "adjournment sine die" 1680 1681 means adjournment on the last legislative day of the regular session and does not include the ensuing 1682 reconvened session.

"Relative" means the donee's spouse, child, uncle, aunt, niece, 1740 nephew, or first cousin; a person to whom the donee is engaged to be married; the donee's or his 1741 spouse's parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, step-parent, step-grandparent, step-grandchild, step-brother, or step-sister; or the donee's brother's or sister's spouse. "Personal friend" does not include 1742 1743 any person that the filer knows or has reason to know is (a) a lobbyist registered pursuant to Article 3 1744 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 2.2 or (b) a lobbyist's principal as defined in § 2.2-419.

2238 B. Any legislator who knowingly and intentionally makes a false statement of a material fact on the 2239 Statement of Economic Interests is guilty of a Class 5 felony and shall be subject to disciplinary action 2240 for such violations by the house in which the legislator sits.

2241 C. The Statement of Economic Interests of all members of each house shall be reviewed by the Council. If a legislator's Statement is found to be inadequate as filed, the legislator shall be notified in 2242 2243 writing and directed to file an amended Statement correcting the indicated deficiencies, and a time shall 2244 be set within which such amendment shall be filed. If the Statement of Economic Interests, in either its 2245 original or amended form, is found to be adequate as filed, the legislator's filing shall be deemed in full 2246 compliance with this section as to the information disclosed thereon.

2247 D. Ten percent of the membership of a house, on the basis of newly discovered facts, may in writing request the house in which those members sit, in accordance with the rules of that house, to review the 2248 2249 Statement of Economic Interests of another member of that house in order to determine the adequacy of 2250 his filing. In accordance with the rules of each house, each Statement of Economic Interests shall be promptly reviewed, the adequacy of the filing determined, and notice given in writing to the legislator whose Statement is in issue. Should it be determined that the Statement requires correction, 2251 2252 2253 augmentation or revision, the legislator involved shall be directed to make the changes required within 2254 such time as shall be set under the rules of each house.

2255 If a legislator, after having been notified in writing in accordance with the rules of the house in 2256 which he sits that his Statement is inadequate as filed, fails to amend his Statement so as to come into 2257 compliance within the time limit set, he shall be subject to disciplinary action by the house in which he 2258 sits. No legislator shall vote on any question relating to his own Statement. 2259

§ 30-129.1. Orientation sessions on ethics and conflicts of interests.

2260 The Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council shall conduct an orientation session (i) 2261 for new and returning General Assembly members preceding each even-numbered year regular session 2262 and (ii) for any new General Assembly member who is elected in a special election and whose term 2263 commences after the date of the orientation session provided for in clause (i) and at least six months before the date of the next such orientation session within three months of his election. Attendance at 2264 2265 the full orientation session shall be mandatory for newly elected members. Attendance at a refresher session lasting at least two hours shall be mandatory for returning members and may be accomplished 2266 2267 by online participation. There shall be no penalty for the failure of a member to attend the full or 2268 refresher orientation session, but the member must disclose his attendance pursuant to § 30-111. No 2269 orientation or refresher session conducted by the Council shall last more than two hours. 2270

§ 30-356.1. Request for approval for certain travel.

2271 A. The Council shall receive and review a request for the approval of travel submitted by a person 2272 required to file the disclosure form prescribed in § 2.2-3117 or 30-111 to accept any travel-related 2273 transportation, lodging, hospitality, food or beverage, or other thing of value that has a value exceeding 2274 \$100 where such approval is required pursuant to subsection G of § 2.2-3103.1 or subsection F of 2275 § 30-103.1. A request for the approval of travel shall not be required for the following, but such travel 2276 shall be disclosed as may be required by the Acts:

1. Travel disclosed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act (§ 24.2-945 et seq.);

2278 2. Travel paid for or provided by the government of the United States, any of its territories, or any 2279 state or any political subdivision of such state;

3. Travel provided to facilitate attendance by a legislator at a regular or special session of the
General Assembly, a meeting of a legislative committee or commission, or a national conference where
attendance is approved by the House or Senate Committee on Rules; or

4. Travel related to an official meeting of the Commonwealth, its political subdivisions, or any board, commission, authority, or other entity, or any charitable organization established pursuant to § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code affiliated with such entity, to which such person has been appointed or elected or is a member by virtue of his office or employment.

2287 5. Travel provided by a nonpartisan state, regional, national, or international legislative
2288 organization, or an affiliated organization of such organization, of which a legislator or an officer or
2289 employee of the legislative branch is a member by virtue of his office or employment; or

2290 6. Travel provided by a charitable organization established pursuant to § 501(c)(3) of the Internal **2291** Revenue Code to a legislator or an officer or employee of the legislative branch if such organization **2292** has been approved by the Joint Rules Committee of the General Assembly to provide such travel.

2293 B. When reviewing a request for the approval of travel, the Council shall consider the purpose of the 2294 travel as it relates to the official duties of the requester. The Council shall approve any request for travel 2295 that bears a reasonable relationship between the purpose of the travel and the official duties of the 2296 requester. Such travel shall include any meeting, conference, or other event (i) composed primarily of 2297 public officials, (ii) at which public policy related to the duties of the requester will be discussed in a 2298 substantial manner, (iii) reasonably expected to educate the requester on issues relevant to his official 2299 duties or to enhance the requester's knowledge and skills relative to his official duties, or (iv) at which 2300 the requester has been invited to speak regarding matters reasonably related to the requester's official 2301 duties.

C. The Council shall not approve any travel requests that bear no reasonable relationship between the purpose of the proposed travel and the official duties of the requester. In making such determination, the Council shall consider the duration of travel, the destination of travel, the estimated value of travel, and any previous or recurring travel.

2306 D. Within five business days of receipt of a request for the approval of travel, the Council shall grant 2307 or deny the request, unless additional information has been requested. If additional information has been 2308 requested, the Council shall grant or deny the request for the approval within five business days of 2309 receipt of such information. If the Council has not granted or denied the request for approval of travel 2310 or requested additional information within such five-day period, such travel shall be deemed to have 2311 been approved by the Council. Nothing in this subsection shall preclude a person from amending or 2312 resubmitting a request for the approval of travel. The Council may authorize a designee to review and 2313 grant or deny requests for the approval of travel.

2314 E. A request for the approval of travel shall be on a form prescribed by the Council and made
2315 available on its website. Such form may be submitted by electronic means, facsimile, in-person
2316 submission, or mail or commercial mail delivery.

F. No person shall be prosecuted, assessed a civil penalty, or otherwise disciplined for acceptance of a travel-related thing of value if he accepted the travel-related thing of value after receiving approval under this section, regardless of whether such approval is later withdrawn, provided the travel occurred prior to the withdrawal of the approval.
