| 10 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-308.1:01 as follows: |
| 11 | § 18.2-308.1:01. Firearm transfers; penalties. |
| 12 | A. Any person not a licensed dealer who conducts business as a merchant of firearms for valuable |
| 13 | consideration may not sell a firearm to a buyer without having a background check of the buyer |
| 14 | conducted by a federally licensed firearms dealer. |
| 15 | B. For purposes of this section, merchant is as defined in § 8.2-104. |
| 16 | C. Notwithstanding the foregoing, unless otherwise required by state or federal law, an individual |
| 17 | who transfers a firearm to a family member, personal friend, by inheritance, by operation of law, or for |
| 18 | a temporary purpose shall not be required to conduct the described background check described by this |
| 19 20 | section. |
| 20 | D. A violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor. |
