3	Commemorating the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Leedstown Resolutions.

8	WHEREAS, February 27, 1766, was the date of the adoption of the Leedstown Resolutions, also
9	known as the Leedstown Resolves, authored by Richard Henry Lee in protest of the British crown's
10	imposition of "taxation without representation"; and
11	WHEREAS, 150 patriots from the counties of Westmoreland, King George, Essex, Stafford,
12	Northumberland, Richmond, Lancaster, Caroline, Spotsylvania, Prince William, Loudoun, and Fairfax,
13	and the City of Fredericksburg would sign <i>Leedstown Resolutions</i> , in which they "most solemnly bind
14 15	ourselvesat the utmost risque of our lives and fortunes"; and WHEREAS, the Northern Neck of Virginia Historical Society was established in 1951 under the
16	leadership of Senator Robert O. Norris, Jr., of Lively, Delegate W. Tayloe Murphy, Sr., of Warsaw, and
17	Delegate Charles F. Unruh of Kinsale, among other notable volunteers; and
18	WHEREAS, the Northern Neck of Virginia Historical Society annually commemorates the <i>Leedstown</i>
19	Resolutions and has held these events throughout the region; and
20	WHEREAS, the celebration of the 250th anniversary of the Leedstown Resolutions will be held on
21	Saturday, February 27, 2016, at Stratford Hall in Westmoreland County, the boyhood home of the
22	author of the Leedstown Resolutions, who was a member of the General Assembly from 1781 to 1785;
23	now, therefore, be it
24	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the 250th anniversary of the
25	signing of the <i>Leedstown Resolutions</i> hereby be commemorated; and, be it
26	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for

27 presentation to the Northern Neck of Virginia Historical Society as an expression of the General
28 Assembly's appreciation for the importance of the *Leedstown Resolutions* to the history and heritage of
29 the nation.
