9	WHEREAS, Virginia law allows for expungement of juvenile court records in limited circumstances
10	and for certain offenses; and
11	WHEREAS, once an adult, a criminal record may hamper employment in a job market where most
12	employers require some kind of criminal record check; and
13	WHEREAS, there are some restrictions in Virginia law barring employment in certain fields, such as
14	child and elder care, for conviction of certain crimes; and
15	WHEREAS, there is no clear understanding of what offenses disqualify persons from employment in
16	general; now, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Commission on Youth be
18	directed to study expungement of juvenile court records.
19	In conducting its study, the Commission on Youth shall assess the need to revise the expungement
20	procedures under the Code of Virginia due to the impediments to employment the current formula
21	presents to young adults with nonviolent juvenile misdemeanor convictions.
22	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Commission on Youth for this
23	study, upon request.
24	The Commission on Youth shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2016, and the chairman
25	shall submit to the Division of Legislative Automated Systems an executive summary of its findings and
26	recommendations no later than the first day of the 2017 Regular Session of the General Assembly. The
27	executive summary shall state whether the Commission on Youth intends to submit to the General
28	Assembly and the Governor a report of its findings and recommendations for publication as a House or

Senate document. The executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website. 29 30
