10	WHEREAS, a proposed amendment to the Constitution of Virginia, hereinafter set forth, was agreed
11	to by a majority of the members elected to each of the two houses of the General Assembly at the
12	regular session of 2015 and referred to this, the next regular session held after the 2015 general election
13	of members of the House of Delegates, as required by the Constitution of Virginia; now, therefore, be it
14	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the following amendment to the
15	Constitution of Virginia be, and the same hereby is, proposed in conformity with the provisions of
16	Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
17	Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article I a section numbered 11-A as follows:
18	ARTICLE I
19	BILL OF RIGHTS
20	Section 11-A. Right to work.
21	Any agreement or combination between any employer and any labor union or labor organization
22	whereby nonmembers of the union or organization are denied the right to work for the employer, or
23	whereby such membership is made a condition of employment or continuation of employment by such
24	employer, or whereby any such union or organization acquires an employment monopoly in any
25	enterprise, is against public policy and constitutes an illegal combination or conspiracy and is void.
